Forced displacement is emerging as an important development challenge. Humanitarian and development actors are increasingly working together to address challenges faced by displaced populations and hosting communities. UNHCR and the World Bank Group (WBG) have been rapidly expanding collaboration, including through joint analytical work and in operations in several regions. One of the most recent areas of collaboration is the IDA18 refugee sub-window, a \$2 billion financing instrument for low-income refugee-hosting countries. The speakers at this event will discuss the UNHCR-WBG partnership and progress on the implementation of the IDA18 refugee sub-window.
