

PROVISIONAL ANNOTATED AGENDA
(5 – 7 July 2000)

1. Adoption of the agenda
2. Adoption of the draft report of the seventeenth meeting of the Standing Committee

The draft report of this meeting, held on 29 February – 2 March 2000, is contained in document EC/50/SC/CRP.13.

3. International protection

The Standing Committee will consider the following sub-items. The documents provided contain elements for a conclusion on international protection. Each sub-item will be introduced and discussed separately:

- (i) *Note on International Protection* (EC/50/SC/CRP.16)
- (ii) *Interception of Asylum-Seekers and Refugees; The International Framework and Recommendations for a Comprehensive Approach* (EC/50/SC/CRP.17)
- (iii) *Complementary forms of Protection: their nature and relationship to the International Refugee Protection Regime* (EC/50/SC/CRP.18)

In addition, a note on UNHCR's role with respect to internally displaced persons (IDPs) (EC/50/SC/INF.2) will be made available.

4. Programme and funding

Under this agenda item, the Standing Committee will consider the following sub-items, each of which will be introduced and discussed separately:

- (i) *Overall Programme and Funding Projections for 2000* (EC/50/SC/CRP.19). The Standing Committee will also consider adopting decisions on the following subjects:
 - (a) *Mobilizing Resources for a unified Budget: The Pledging conference* (EC/50/SC/CRP.14).
 - (b) *Guiding Principles applicable to the Resourcing of UNHCR's unified Budget* (EC/50/SC/CRP.22).

In addition, oral strategic presentations will precede discussion on policy developments in the following regions:

- (c) Americas
 - (d) Asia and the Pacific
 - (e) Europe
 - (f) South-Eastern Europe
- (ii) Global Report on Activities in 1999

5. Protection/Programme Policy

Under this item, the following issues will be introduced and discussed successively:

- (i) *Social and Economic Impact of Massive Refugee populations on host developing countries, as well as other countries* (EC/50/SC/CRP.21).
- (ii) *Safety and Security of Staff* (EC/50/SC/INF.3) and *The Security, Civilian and Humanitarian Character of Refugee Camps and Settlements* (EC/50/SC/INF.4).

6. Coordination

The Standing Committee will receive an oral update on coordination issues within the United Nations system, as well as preparations for the World Conference against Racism, Racial Discrimination, Xenophobia and Related Intolerance.

7. Governance

The Standing Committee will give final consideration to the selection of the annual theme for the fifty-first session of the Executive Committee. A draft decision will be before the Standing Committee.

8. Management, finance, oversight and human resources

The Standing Committee will consider *Follow-up on the actions taken to implement the recommendations of the Board of Auditors in its report for the year ended 31 December 1998*. (EC/50/SC/CRP.20).
