REPORT ON THE WORK OF THE STANDING COMMITTEE

### I. INTRODUCTION

1. At its fifty-first session in October 2000, the Executive Committee adopted a decision on the programme of work of the Standing Committee in 2001 (A/AC.96/944, paragraph 29) in which it sets out the issues to be examined by the Standing Committee.

2. In accordance with Executive Committee Working Methods adopted at the forty-sixth session (A/AC.96/860, paragraph 32), the Standing Committee has held three meetings over the past year: in March, June and September 2001. A planning meeting of Executive Committee members in December 2000 established the calendar of meetings and determined the distribution of the different agenda items in 2001 (see Annex I). Members of the Executive Committee, in acknowledgment of the need for multi-year planning, also took note of the programme of work of the Standing Committee for the years 2002 and 2003 (Annex 1).

3. A detailed account of the work undertaken at each of the meetings of the Standing Committee over the past year is contained in the following reports: *Report of the Twentieth Meeting of the Standing Committee* (A/AC.96/945); *Report of the Twenty-first Meeting of the Standing Committee* (A/AC.96/956); and *Report of the Twenty-Second Meeting of the Standing Committee* (A/AC.96/958).

### II. ISSUES COVERED BY THE STANDING COMMITTEE IN 2001

4. The work undertaken by the Standing Committee included a number of recurrent items. These concerned reviews of UNHCR's programmes and activities in various regions on the basis of oral updates, designed to allow the Standing Committee to oversee the strategy and evolution of these programmes and the essential challenges for the future. Africa and Central Asia, South-West Asia, North Africa and the Middle East, Asia and the Pacific were reviewed in March; and the Americas, Europe, including South-Eastern Europe, in June.

5. At each meeting, the Standing Committee considered regular updates on overall programme and funding issues, through which it was kept informed of the situation in terms of programme requirements and funding levels. In June, the Standing Committee considered the Global Report on UNHCR's activities in 2000. In September a Mid-Year Progress Report was presented on UNHCR's activities in the first half of 2001.

6. Programme/protection policy issues were reviewed by the Standing Committee at all of its meetings. In March, it noted measures taken under the Plan of Action for emergency preparedness and response drawn up in 2000, and action taken to reinforce and strengthen staff safety and security, as well as refugee security. Other topics covered at this meeting included a progress report on reintegration; presentation of a community development approach to refugee situations; and a discussion on the need for a global approach to the problem of HIV/Aids which was a particular threat to refugees. At its June meeting, the Standing Committee considered the economic and social impact of refugee populations on host developing countries, as well as other countries, and also issues concerning refugee women. In September, the Standing Committee was briefed on UNHCR's contingency plan for a potentially huge exodus of Afghans to neighbouring countries (under "Any other business").

7. The June meeting of the Standing Committee focused particularly on questions of international protection. An update on the Global Consultations on International Protection was discussed at this meeting, and UNHCR's activities in the field of statelessness and issues concerning resettlement were also considered.

8. At each meeting during the year, the Standing Committee received an oral briefing on coordination issues within the United Nations system that focused on UNHCR's participation in the various coordinating mechanisms and its perspective on major issues under discussion.

9. In June, issues of management, finance, oversight and human resources reviewed by the Standing Committee covered UNHCR's inspection and evaluation plans and activities, as well as - for the first time - human resources management. The September meeting undertook a preliminary review of financial and budgetary documentation being submitted to the fifty-first session of the Executive Committee.

10. At its March session, under governance issues, the Standing Committee discussed the question of the selection of an annual theme for the fifty-second session of the Executive Committee. 2001 being the first year of the mandate of the newly-elected High Commissioner, it was considered useful to replace the traditional annual theme with a debate based on the High Commissioner's perspective on the work of his Office. The Standing Committee also recalled the changes to the Executive Committee's annual session introduced in 2000, and discussed suggestions for further enhancements to the format for the fifty-second session in 2001.

11. In accordance with what has now become standard practice for the Committee, informal consultations took place in the course of the year on issues requiring in-depth discussion. These included: UNHCR's budget; the evaluation function; security issues; human resources; HIV/Aids; and decentralization.

### III. STANDING COMMITTEE DECISIONS AND CONCLUSIONS

12. In accordance with the authority vested in it by the Executive Committee, the Standing Committee adopted a number of decisions and conclusions on matters included in its programme of work. The texts of these decisions are annexed to the reports of the different Standing Committee meetings, as follows:
