

ANGOLA: Expulsions



20 Oct 2009 - Close to **30,000 Angolans** recently expelled from the Democratic Republic of the Congo are living in overcrowded reception centres in and around Mama Rosa (in Luvo) and Cuimba, Angola and are in need of shelter, food, medicine and sanitation facilities. The forced returns came in response to the waves of expulsions of large numbers of Congolese from Angola since December 2008.
