2.2 Administrative/Biographical	history The International Refugee Organization (IRO) was created in July 1947. It was a non-permanent Specialized Agency of the United Nations. When UNHCR succeeded the IRO in 1951 the new organization adopted the same filing system.
2.4 Immediate source of acquisition The records were transferred from BO Brussels to UNHCR Archives in three shipments: Series 1in April 2003, Series 2 in June 1999 and Series 3 in July 2004.	
3.1 Scope and content	The records include the records of the IRO office in Brussels and the records of UNHCR Branch Office Brussels, later called Branch Office for Belgium and Luxembourg and, from 1989 onwards, Region Office for the Benelux Countries and European Institutions. The records of Series 1 document the work of IRO and UNHCR in dealing with the aftermath of World War II and cover the period up to 1963. Series 2 covers the years 1975 to 1994 and contains records related to projects, assistance, statistics, the "program d'acceuil" of Indochinese and Latin American refugees and individual case information. Series 3 includes mission reports, correspondence related to UNHCR relations with European institutions, refugee resettlement and naturalization for the period 1975 to 1998. Of particular interest are the files dealing with Indochinese and Latin American refugees in Series 2 and 3.
