2.2 Administrative/Biographical history The UNHCR Branch Office in Tirana was established in

February 1992 as a small operation focussed on the dissemination of information with regard to international refugee and human rights law and strengthening legal protection for refugees in Albania. UNHCR BO Tirana worked closely with the Albanian government on the drafting of the Albanian Asylum Law, approved by the Albanian Parliament in December 1998.

During 1999, field offices were set up in Elbasan, Durres, Shkodra, Korka and Fier to respond to the massive influx of Kosovo refugees. The main point of entry was Kukes, where a small UNHCR field office had been established in 1998. A field office in the border area of Barjam Curri, established in June 1998, was closed several months later when the security situation deteriorated.

2.4 Immediate source of acquisition The records were transferred from UNHCR BO Tirana to UNHCR Archives in November 2001.

3.1 Scope and content

While several files from BO Tirana cover the work of UNHCR prior to 1998, the records deal predominantly with the massive influx of Kosovo refugees during the period of May 1998 to June 1999.

In addition to correspondence (letters, faxes, cables and printed email), the records contain field operation reports by camp and NGO, camp profiles, situation reports, notes for the file, cargo and stock reports and statistics. The records include individual refugee case information.
