3.1 Scope and content Between 1997 and 2001 UNHCR registered approximately 130,000

refugees from Western Sahara. The records consist of registration forms of the Saharaoui refugees prepared for a population census by the UNHCR Branch Office in Tindouf. This registration was part

of the United Nations framework for the Western Sahara Referendum as well as the eventual repatriation of Saharaoui

refugees to Western Sahara.
