The "Sans No" series has a number of records on early pubic awareness activities. The project records, which often are related to construction of facilities for refugees, contain architectural drawings for proposed buildings in locations from Beirut to Hong Kong. The two reports in series four, from Vienna and Zurich in 1952, provide information on the social conditions in which refugees found themselves.               |
