- 2.2 Administrative/Biographical history** Danish statesman and politician Poul Hartling served two terms as High Commissioner, from 1978-1985. Having previously served as Foreign Minister and then Prime Minister of Denmark, he accepted the Nobel Peace prize on behalf of UNHCR in 1981.
- 3.1 Scope and content** The Subject and Mission files document the work of the Office of the High Commissioner from 1977-1985. Briefs for meetings of the HC from July 1977 through 1982 are indexed by year and some pre-date the appointment of Poul Hartling. The Weekly Notes on the Activities of UNHCR (1978-1984) provide an inside look at all aspects of the issues at hand during this period. The records include Policy Committee files containing agendas as well as the decisions of the committee from 1982-1985.
