Outline of opening remarks by António Guterres, United Nations High Commissioner for Refugees

(Geneva, 30 September 2013)

In his opening remarks to the High-Level Segment, the High Commissioner will provide a brief general overview of the challenges facing refugee hosting countries and outline the Segment's objective of mobilizing more international solidarity and burden-sharing with these States.

- <u>Situation of Syrian refugees in the region</u>: overview of refugee numbers in Lebanon, Jordan, Turkey, Iraq and Egypt; praise for the generosity of hosting countries.
- Impact of the refugee presence on hosting countries: proportional share of refugees in Lebanese population; refugee presence further compounds economic and security impact of the Syria crisis; pressure on local authorities and host communities in all services; budgetary impact on host governments.
- Appeal for a political solution to the conflict
- Humanitarian and non-political focus of the High-Level Segment
- Appeal for international solidarity with host countries: humanitarian and development assistance supporting refugee hosting communities; call to action for bilateral development programmes and international financial institutions; appeal to grant all Syrians access to protection at international borders; outline of burdensharing mechanisms such as resettlement and humanitarian admission in third countries.
