These questions can be used to set up a debate in class. You can choose a "for" group and an "against" group.

The questions can also be used for students to discuss and research findings in groups and write essays on their opinions and research.

HOW TO: Split the class into two groups. Below are three statements. Give out the same statement, one at a time, to both groups. Give them 5-10 minutes to come up with an answer. Let each group present their answers, followed by a debate between both groups.

After finishing a debate, repeat the process with the next statement.

1: "Refugees are looking for protection but migrants are looking for a better standard of living or better work opportunities therefore other countries should not allow them to come in."

2: "The history of the world is such that everyone is a migrant."
