



## **GLOBAL RESETTLEMENT**

Expanded resettlement and complementary pathways for refugees are tangible mechanisms for burden and responsibility-sharing, which are central to the global compact on refugees.

States have made commitments in the New York Declaration to aim to provide resettlement places and complementary pathways for admission on a scale commensurate with the annual needs identified by UNHCR.
