I. INTRODUCTION

- ❑ The figures in this document were provided by Governments and compiled and analyzed by UNHCR. They should be considered provisional and subject to change. No asylum data were available for Finland (September) and Italy (January to September). Whereas the previous documents on monthly asylum trends were limited to Europe, this issue includes Canada and the United States.

II. TRENDS IN APPLICATIONS

A. QUARTERLY TRENDS

- ❑ During the third quarter of 2000, some 106,600 asylum applications were submitted in the 24 European countries listed in Table 1, 17% more than during the second quarter of 2000, when 91,200 applications were lodged. Compared to the first quarter of 2000, when 96,500 asylum-seekers were recorded, the number of applications submitted during the third quarter rose by 11%.
- ❑ Countries experiencing a relatively significant decline in applications submitted during the third quarter as compared to the second quarter were Hungary (-10%), Norway (-32%), Romania (-18%) and Slovakia (-22%). Conversely, countries receiving significantly more applicants during the third quarter as compared to the second include Austria (24%), Belgium (52%), Bulgaria (27%), Denmark (24%), Germany (24%), Greece (34%), Poland (24%), Slovenia (289%) and Sweden (47%). The significant increase in asylum applications in Slovenia is due to a rise in Iranian asylum applications from 200 or less during January to June to 1,120 in August and almost 700 in September.
- ❑ From the first to the third quarter of 2000, the largest increase in asylum applications was recorded by Austria (40%), Belgium (59%), Czech Republic (42%), Norway (59%), Slovenia (381%) and Sweden (32%). During the same period, significant decreases were recorded in Denmark (-19%), France (-18%), Luxembourg (-23%) and Romania (-39%).
- ❑ As a result of the above changes, the share of Germany in the total number of applications lodged in Europe increased from 18.7% during the second quarter of 2000 19.9% during the third, whereas the share of the United Kingdom (UK) fell slightly, from 19.7% to 18.3%. Significantly, Belgium surpassed the Netherlands as Europe's third largest asylum-seeker receiving country as its share in the total number of applications lodged increased from 8.9% during the second quarter to 11.6% during the third.
- ❑ In Canada, the number of asylum applications rose with 24% from the second to the third quarter of 2000 and with 5% from the first to the third. In the United States, the increase from the second to third quarter (19%), was lower than in Canada, but the increase from the first to the third quarter (30%) was higher.

B. MONTHLY TRENDS (SEE TABLE 1)

- ❑ During September 2000, some 36,200 asylum applications were lodged in Europe, 2% less than during August, when 37,000 persons applied for asylum. The total number of asylum applications lodged in Europe during September 2000

(36,200) was 4% lower than during September 1999 (37,500), but 1% higher than during September 1998 (36,000).

- ❑ In September 2000, the largest relative increase in the number of monthly asylum applications was reported by Bulgaria (+31%), Greece (226%), Luxembourg (+81%), Poland (+21%) and Romania (22%). The largest decrease in monthly asylum applications was experienced by the Netherlands (-14%), Portugal (-22%), Slovenia (-34%), Spain (-16%) and the United States (-22%).
- ❑ In September 2000, Germany received 20% of all asylum applications lodged in Europe, followed by the United Kingdom (18%), Belgium (13%) and the Netherlands (10%).

II. ORIGIN OF ASYLUM APPLICANTS

A. QUARTERLY TRENDS (TABLE 2 AND 3)

- ❑ From the second to the third quarter of 2000, countries of origin experiencing a significant increase in the number of applications lodged in Europe and North America include Czech Republic (173%), the Islamic Rep. of Iran (96%), Bulgaria and Bosnia and Herzegovina (each 77%), Slovakia (74%), Syrian Arab Republic (71%), Albania (64%), and Iraq (58%).
- ❑ From the second to the third quarter of 2000, countries of origin experiencing a significant decrease in the number of applications lodged in Europe and North America include Federal Rep. of Yugoslavia (-18%), the Republic of Congo, Poland and Haiti (each -13%).

B. MONTHLY TRENDS (TABLE 2 AND 3)

- ❑ The number of asylum-seekers from Federal Republic of Yugoslavia (FRY), the largest source country of asylum-seekers in Europe and North America for a considerable period, continues to fall during the most recent months, whereas the number of Iraqi and Iranian asylum applications is rapidly rising. As a result, these two countries replaced FRY as the largest countries of origin of asylum-seekers during August and September 2000.
- ❑ Nevertheless, FRY remains the largest country of origin of asylum applicants during the first nine months of 2000, accounting for 10% of all applications lodged in Europe and North America, followed by Iraq (7%) and Afghanistan (6%).
- ❑ The main countries of origin of asylum-seekers in North America are quite different than in Europe. In North America, China was the largest country of origin of asylum-seekers during the first nine months of 2000, accounting for 5,600 asylum-seekers, followed by Mexico (4,030), Haiti (3,840), Colombia (3,060) and Pakistan (2,490). In Europe, the largest source countries were FRY (34,200), Iraq (23,600), Afghanistan (20,000), the Islamic Rep. of Iran (16,900) and Turkey (15,700).
