

PROVISIONAL ANNOTATED ORDER OF BUSINESS  
(1 October 2004)1. Opening of the Forum

Opening statement by the United Nations High Commissioner for Refugees, including an introduction of the *Progress Report: Convention Plus* (FORUM/2004/5). Comments on this statement will be invited by the Chairman under item 3.

2. Presentation of the Multilateral Framework of Understandings on Resettlement

Canada, the facilitating State of the Core Group on this strand of Convention Plus, will present to the Forum the *Multilateral Framework of Understandings on Resettlement* (FORUM/2004/6), which was developed by the Core Group, for consideration by Forum participants as to how best it can be applied.

3. Updates by facilitating States on addressing irregular secondary movements of refugees and asylum-seekers and targeting development assistance to achieve durable solutions

Representatives of facilitating States will present updates to the Forum. Following these updates, the floor will be open for discussion. In addition, the floor will be opened on the High Commissioner's opening statement and the *Progress Report: Convention Plus* (FORUM/2004/5).

- (i) Addressing irregular secondary movements of refugees and asylum-seekers (South Africa and Switzerland).
- (ii) Targeting development assistance to achieve durable solutions (Denmark and Japan).
- (iii) Discussion of the High Commissioner's opening statement and the *Progress Report: Convention Plus* (FORUM/2004/5).

4. Comprehensive approaches to durable solutions

Opportunities for developing comprehensive plans of action to resolve specific refugee situations, particularly those that have been protracted for years, are being considered within the context of Convention Plus. The Chairman will open the floor for discussion after the presentation of each sub-item.

- (i) The Director of the Bureau for Africa will introduce an *Information Note: Preparatory project for the elaboration of a Comprehensive Plan of Action for Somali Refugees* (FORUM/2004/8) and provide further information on the progress being achieved in developing the Comprehensive Plan of Action for Somalia.
- (ii) Other comprehensive approaches, as reflected in *Making comprehensive approaches to resolving refugee problems more systematic* (FORUM/2004/7).
