Introduction

1. The statistics presented here were reported by UNHCR Offices located in countries of asylum. In total, 80 UNHCR country offices reported refugee statistics for the first quarter of 2003. The statistics presented here should be considered as provisional, subject to change. Industrialized countries are not included in this survey. The country codes used in the tables are explained in Annex I.

POPULATION CHANGES

2. In the 80 asylum countries considered, the refugee population remained remarkably stable. During the first quarter of 2003, the population in these 80 countries combined fell by 1%, from 7,125,800 as at 1 January 2003 to 7,072,500 as at 31 March 2003. The refugee population directly assisted by or through UNHCR also decreased by 1%, from 5.2 million at the beginning to 5.1 million at the end of the period (see *Table 1*).

3. Among the 39 countries hosting more than 5,000 refugees at the end of the period, two recorded an **increase** in the refugee population of 5% or more. In Yemen, a 6% increase was recorded following an influx of 5,100 Somali refugees, whereas in Malaysia, the refugee population increased by 25% as a result of new, higher estimates for the number of refugees from the Philippines (+12,100) (see *Tables 1 and 2*).

4. Four countries hosting more than 5,000 refugees recorded a **decrease** in the refugee population of at least 5%. In Côte d'Ivoire, the refugee figure fell by 18% following the return of some 8,000 refugees to Liberia. In Burundi, 11% fewer refugees were reported following registration at two locations with refugees from the Democratic Republic (DR) of Congo. In Croatia, the refugee population fell by 8% due to a combination of voluntary repatriation, resettlement and administrative corrections. Finally, Russian Federation recorded a drop in the refugee population of 5%, mainly due to a decline in the Georgian refugee population (-700) (see *Tables 1 and 2*).

NEW ARRIVALS

5. Among the 80 asylum countries included here, **new arrivals** including more than 1,000 refugees were reported by the United Rep. of Tanzania (10,600), Guinea (6,900), Yemen (5,100), Uganda (4,900), Zambia (1,400) and Kenya (1,300) (see *Table 1*). These outflows concerned mostly refugees from Burundi (6,800) fleeing to the United Rep. of Tanzania, refugees from DR Congo fleeing to the United Rep. of Tanzania (3,700) and Zambia (1,300), refugees from Côte d'Ivoire (2,000) and Liberia (4,900) fleeing to Guinea, Somali refugees arriving in Yemen (5,100) and Sudanese refugees arriving in Uganda (4,900) and Kenya (1,200) (see *Tables 2 and 3*).

DURABLE SOLUTIONS

6. **Voluntary repatriation** departures involving more than 1,000 refugees¹ were reported by the UNHCR country offices in the Islamic Rep. of Iran (20,200 Afghan refugees), the United Rep. of Tanzania (8,300 refugees from Burundi and 860 from Rwanda), Guinea (8,250 refugees from Sierra Leone and 580 refugees from Côte d'Ivoire), Côte d'Ivoire (8,000 Liberian refugees), Pakistan (5,600 Afghan refugees) and DR Congo (2,700 refugees from Angola and 2,600 refugees from Rwanda) (see *Tables 1 and 4*).

¹ These figures are based on the reporting of countries of asylum only. Often, they do not take into account the spontaneous return of refugees registered by the country of origin.

7. UNHCR offices in the 80 asylum countries included in this report resettled some 4,000 refugees during the first three months of 2003, 12 of which facilitated more than 100 departures. Most **resettlement departures** facilitated by UNHCR took place from Kenya (630), Egypt (460), Turkey (430), Pakistan (390), the Islamic Rep. of Iran (310) and Guinea (270) (see *Table 1*). Within these 80 asylum countries, the nationalities benefiting mostly from resettlement opportunities included refugees from Afghanistan (850), Sudan (705), Iraq (490), the Islamic Rep. of Iran (340), Ethiopia (250), Somalia (215), Liberia (195), Serbia and Montenegro (110) and Croatia (100).

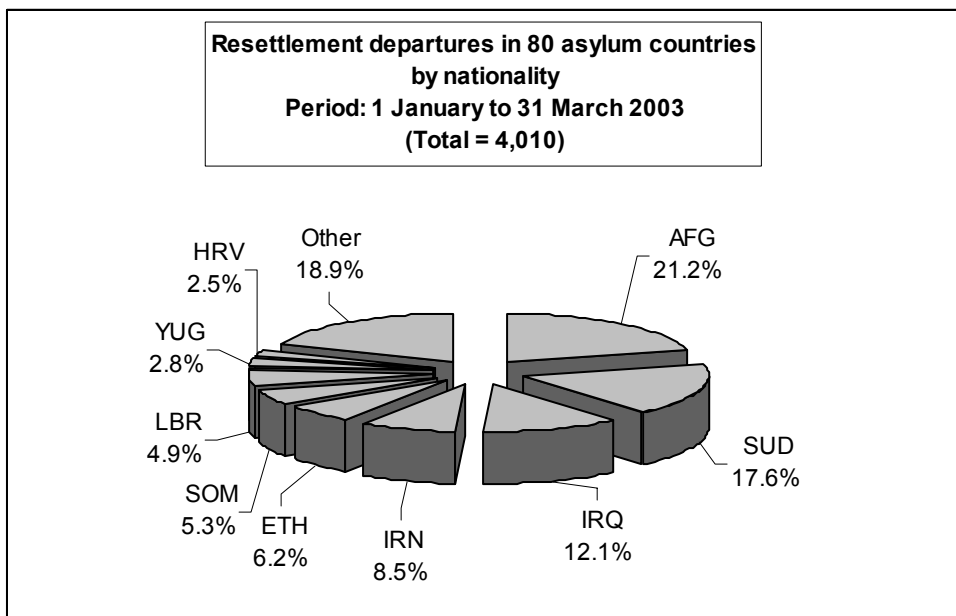
