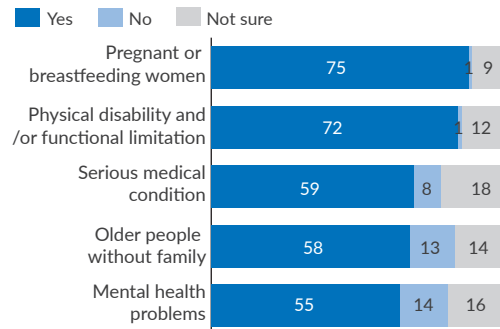

**Top 3 main concerns related to food in the community**



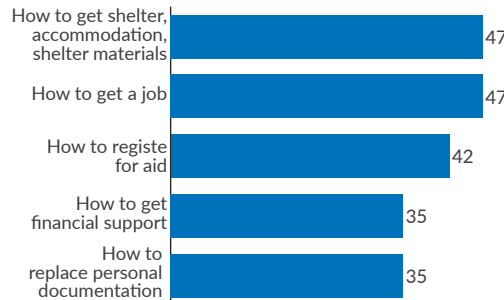

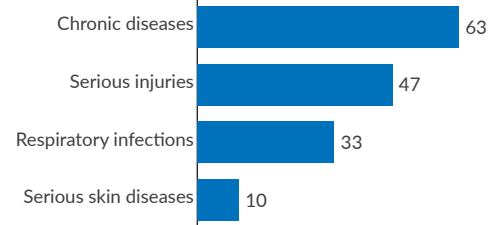
**Context**

In the last week of September 2023, following renewed hostilities in the South Caucasus region, refugees began arriving rapidly in Armenia. Within a week, some 100,000 refugees had crossed the border. They are in urgent need of protection and support. Between 9 and 13 October, humanitarian partners conducted a rapid needs assessment.

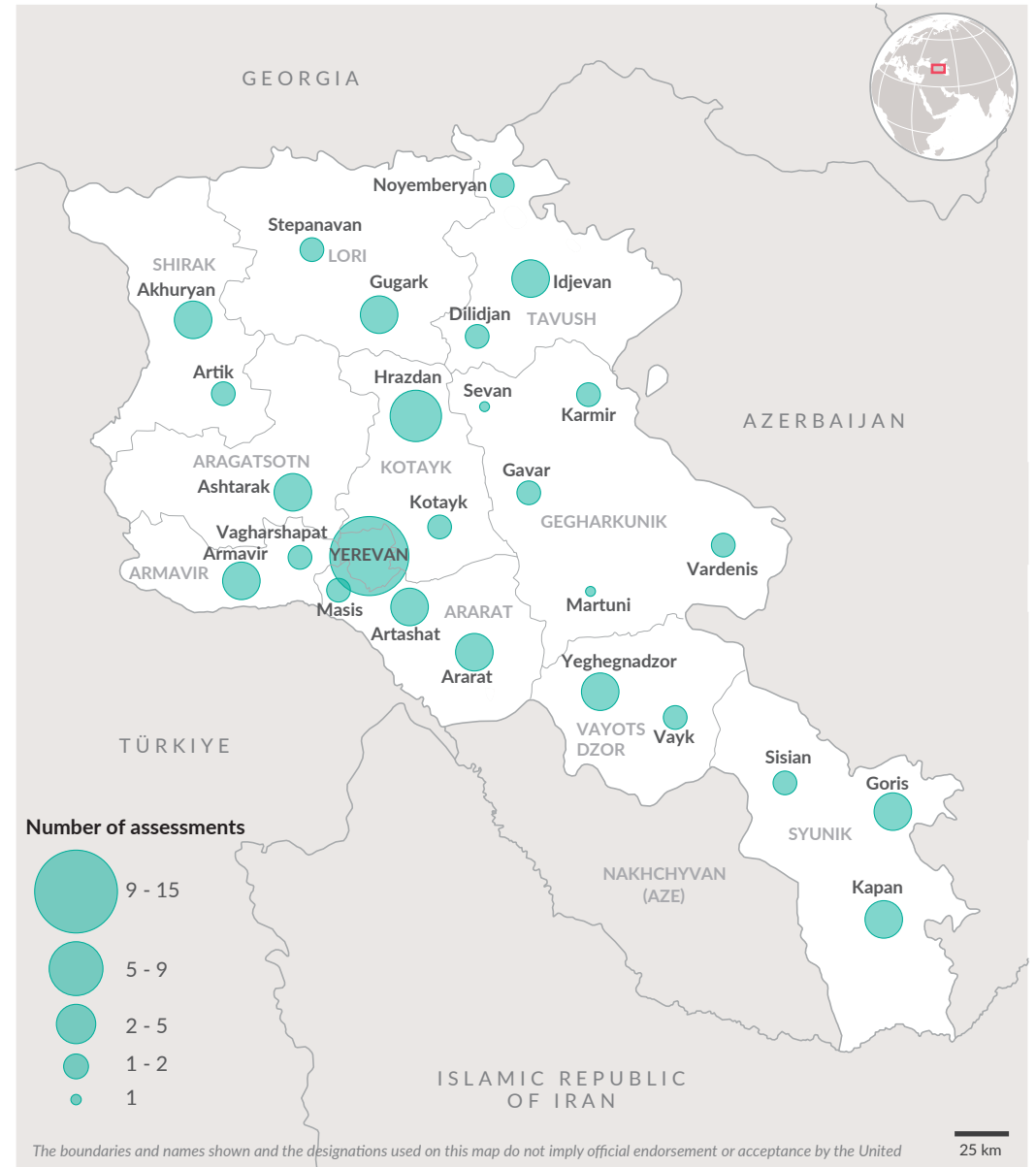
**Top 5 information needs requested by the community**



**KI aware of persons with the following health conditions**

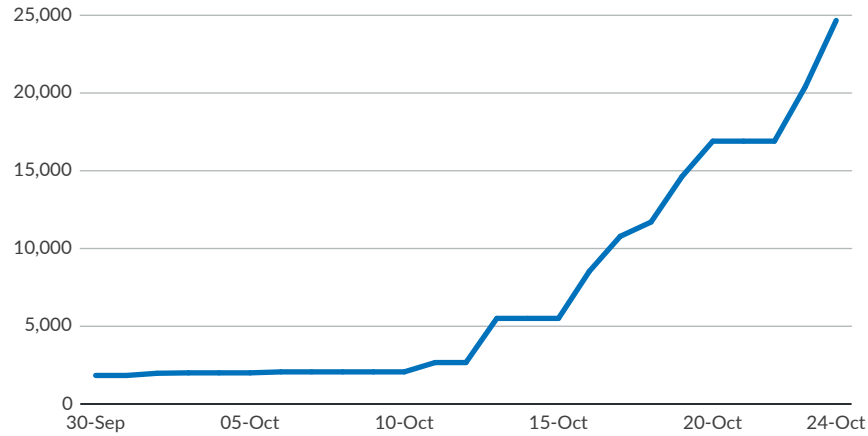

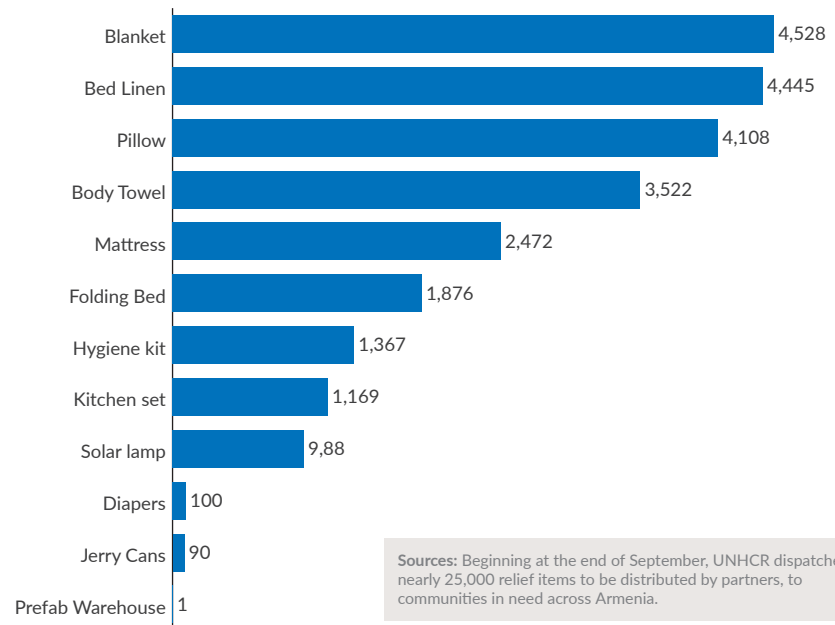


### Relief items provided by UNHCR
