

ASYLUM TRENDS IN INDUSTRIALIZED COUNTRIES, MAY 2003

1. In the 26 industrialized countries for which data for April and May were available¹, 28,600 asylum applications were submitted in May 2003, 10 per cent less than in April 2003, when 31,830 applications were lodged. Although the latest data for the largest asylum-seeker receiving country, the United Kingdom, are not yet available, this trend suggests that the monthly number of applications submitted in industrialized countries in May reached the lowest level of the past few years (see chart).

2. The fall in monthly applications was noticeable in all regions, ranging from -6 per cent in Western Europe to -19 per cent in North America (*Table 1*).



3. Of the 26 countries which reported data for April and May 2003, 9 countries experienced an increase in monthly asylum applications, whereas 17 countries reported a decrease. A relatively significant **increase** in monthly applications during May was reported by Bulgaria (36%) and Greece (57%). Conversely, important **decreases** in monthly asylum flows were reported for France (-33%), Portugal (-44%), Romania (-44%), New Zealand (-32%) and Japan (-38%) (*Table 1*).

4. Among the ten major countries of origin in the 26 countries with available data, a decrease in monthly asylum claims was reported for asylum-seekers from Iraq (-24%), Turkey (-15%), China (-3%), the Democratic Rep. of Congo (-24%) and the Islamic Rep. of Iran (-2%). Major countries of origin recording an increase in monthly asylum-seeker claims were Russian Federation (2%), Serbia and Montenegro (2%), Afghanistan (3%), Nigeria (3%) and India (6%). As a result of the sharp fall in Iraqi asylum claims, the Russian Federation became the main country of origin of asylum-seekers in the 26 asylum countries in May 2003 (*Table 2*).

5. Table 3 provides an overview of monthly asylum applications lodged by origin and country of asylum for May 2003.
