Background of the training

As part of the roll-out in the Central Europe region of the Teaching About Refugees project, UNHCR would like to launch this project in Slovenia and provide training of both primary and secondary school teachers throughout Slovenia. UNHCR created a complete catalogue of teaching materials translated into Slovenian language to support teachers in primary and secondary education in teaching the topic of refugees, asylum and migration in a fact-based and age-appropriate manner. The Teaching About Refugees catalogue also contains guidance for teachers working with refugee children who are learning new languages and may be suffering from stress or trauma as a result of their journey to safety.

Objectives of the training

The objective of this project is to train primary and secondary school teachers and provide them with high quality teaching materials on refugees, asylum, and migration to increase knowledge on the part of teachers and pupils in primary and secondary education. Better understanding and fact-based learning about the topic will contribute to more balanced and critical thinking about refugees and will underscore the importance of a welcoming and inclusive school environment.

Trainers

Trainers need to have demonstrated training skills and prior experience with delivery of training. Trainers will be expected to hold half day trainings in 10 schools throughout Slovenia hosting refugees and migrants.

The estimated number of participants

Between March and December 2020, 150 teachers to be trained in total.
Between 10-15 teachers will be trained per training session.
