- 6. Are you going to claim the right to vote in Farlandian elections? Why would that be important to you?
- 7. Will you demand access to healthcare, unemployment benefits and pensions with the same rights as born-and-bred Farlandians? If so, should these rights apply from day one?
- 8. Should adults be allowed to refuse a job they are offered, if the job doesn't make use of their qualifications? If so, why?
- 9. What might the Farlandian people do to make you feel welcome and included in local society?
