



UNHCR IN NUMBERS

APRIL - JUNE 2022


Registration, Refugee Status Determination and Resettlement

-  **25,932** individuals received new and continuous registration services
-  **4** mobile registration missions to Damietta and Matrouh
-  **2,869** RSD interviews conducted
-  **2,913** RSD decisions finalized
-  **877** persons departed to **6** countries



Community-based Protection and Communication with Communities

-  **54,801** calls responded to by UNHCR Egypt infoline
-  **508** persons with specific needs were supported
-  **7** meetings organized, attended by **282** community leaders
-  **127** refugee and Egyptian learners benefitted from four computer learning centres
-  **80,082** times the Help website was accessed
-  **186,628** reached on two UNHCR-run Facebook pages
-  **2** live Q&A sessions organized to respond to refugee questions



Gender-based Violence

-  **290** women, men, girls and boys attended different GBV awareness activities


Child Protection

-  **1,698** unaccompanied and separated children (UASC) provided with case management services
-  **435** best interests assessments conducted for UASC and for children at risk



Legal Assistance

-  **1,586** received counseling, legal assistance & support with child birth registration
-  **398** released from detention following UNHCR's intervention

Protection Counselling

-  **2,225** benefited from protection counselling



Cash-based Interventions (CBI)

-  **11,846** families were supported with multipurpose CBI
-  **2,285** UASC received CBI to mitigate protection risks & meet basic needs

Health

-  **7,968** persons with non-communicable diseases treated
-  **25,736** received primary health assistance
-  **689** life-saving emergencies attended to
-  **2,642** medical referrals for secondary and tertiary healthcare
-  **20** assisted with registration for the COVID vaccine

Livelihoods

-  **2,792** received training sessions, guidance on labour market opportunities, job placement services
-  **59** refugees started/enlarged their businesses with UNHCR support
