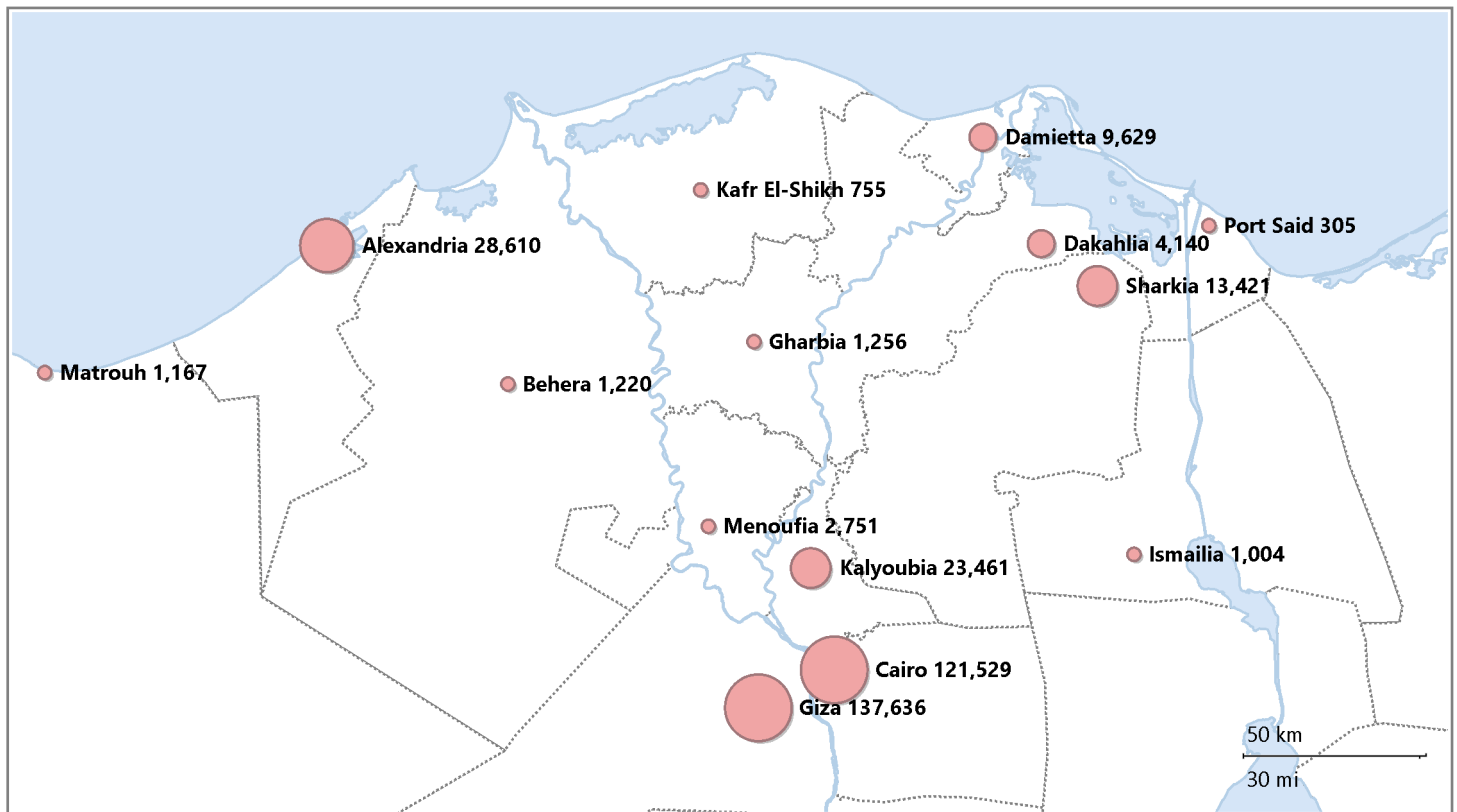

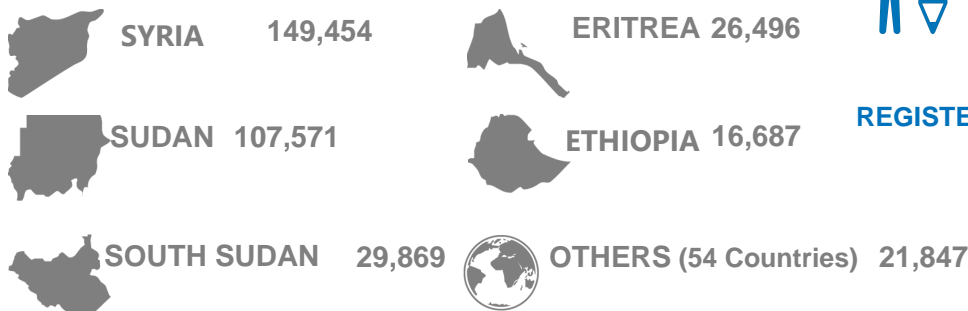

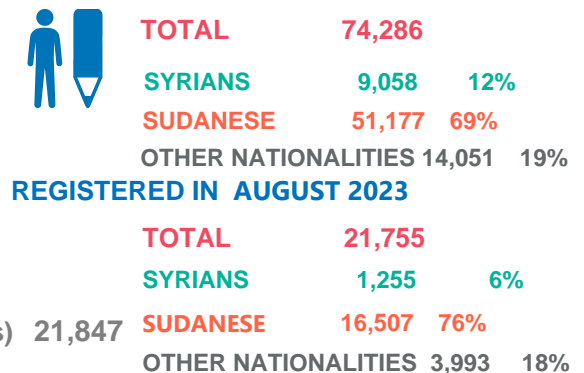

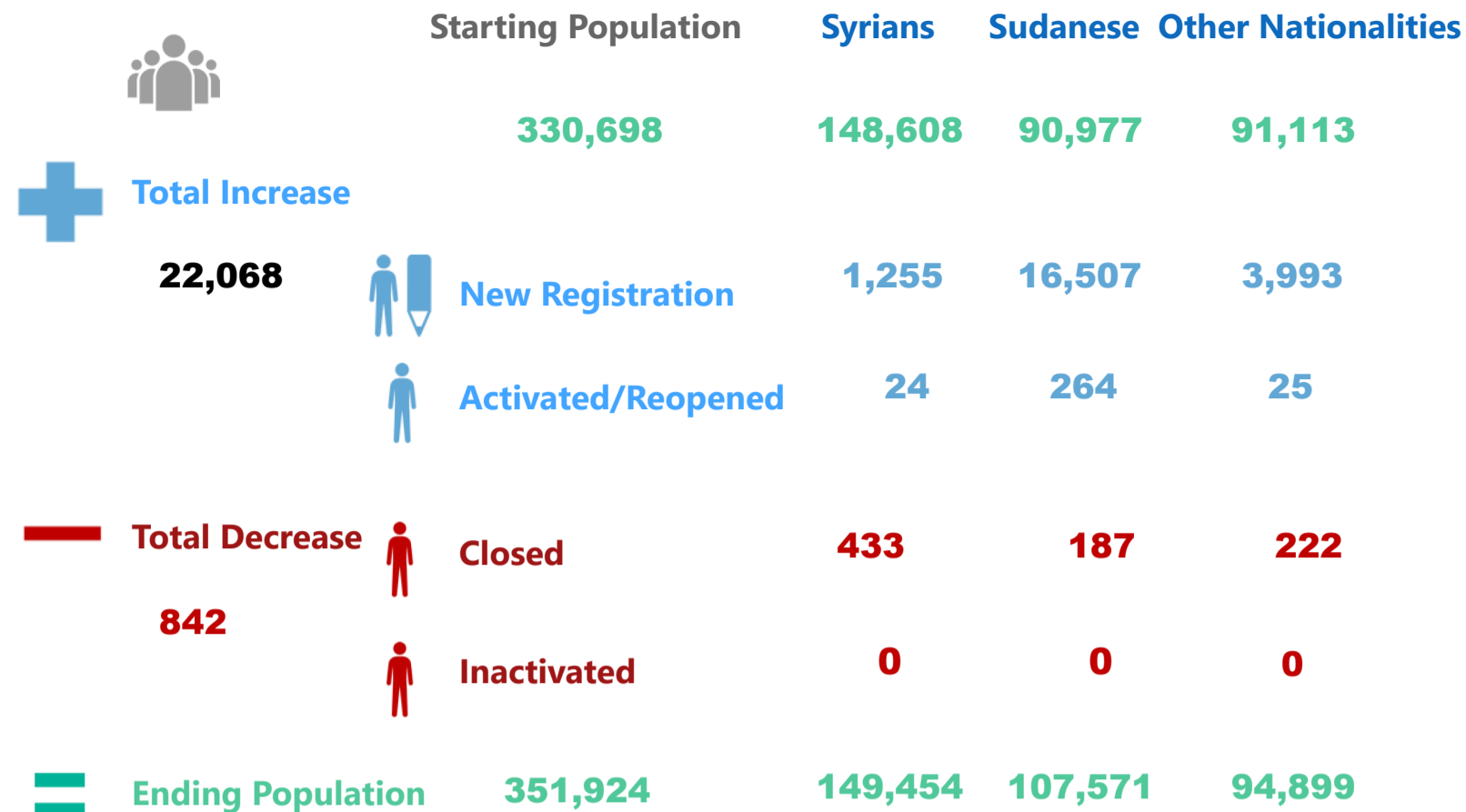
## BREAKDOWN BY COUNTRY OF ORIGIN
