

ANNEX A: TERMS OF REFERENCE

FOR THE ESTABLISHMENT OF CONTRACT(S) FOR THE PROVISION OF ELECTRICITY AT UNHCR PREMISES IN GREECE

(LESVOS, SAMOS, CHIOS, THESSALONIKI)

Background

The scope of this tender is the identification of one or more suppliers for the supply of electricity for the needs of the UNHCR Premises in Lesvos, Chios, Samos and Thessaloniki.

The aim is to reduce the electricity cost of UNHCR, contributing to the overall reduction of its operating costs while in parallel guarantee reliable services for the organization.

<u>UNHCR</u> intends to establish Contract(s) for twelve (12) months, with fixed tariff for the whole duration of the contract, with possibility of extension for one additional year. Penalty fees on possible early termination of contract should be indicated in the quotation.

Payment terms

UNHCR shall, following receipt of services and all related and required supporting documentation specified in the Contract, make payment by bank transfer to the Contractor's bank account within 30 days of receipt of the Contractor's detailed invoice, unless otherwise specified in the Contract or Purchase Order.

UNHCR payments may be processed through UNHCR Headquarters accounts, and as such, will be received by the Contractor's designated local bank account as an international incoming transfer. In any case, UNHCR is not liable/responsible for any commission charges, depending upon the agreement the Contractor has with its bank. This should be taken into consideration and be included in the financial quote of each bidder.

Special Requirements and Conditions

The Contractor is expected to provide information to the designated UNHCR staff members in respect to services provided.

All communication between UNHCR and the Contractor shall be exclusively in English and in writing.

The Supplier's Contract Manager response time should be prompt; e-mails are acknowledged within 24 hours, phone calls returned within 2 hours, and response/solutions proposed to UNHCR suggestions and/or problems within 3 days.

<u>UNHCR General Conditions of Contracts for the provision of Services (Annex C)</u>: Any Contract or Purchase Order that will be issued as a result of this tender shall be subject to the General Terms and Conditions attached hereto. The mere act of submission of a Proposal implies that the Service Provider accepts without question the General Terms and Conditions of UNHCR.
