

UNHCR Programme Management Cycle







GLOBAL STRATEGY FOR SAFE ACCESS TO FUEL AND ENERGY (SAFE) 2014-2018






VISION

Carbon Financing

ADDRESSING ENERGY NEEDS SUSTAINABLY

UNHCR has teamed up with climate protection organisation atmosfair to bring fuel-efficient stoves to refugees in Rwanda. Through this first carbon financing agreement, UNHCR hopes to increase refugee access to energy, decrease environmental degradation and to reduce carbon emission. It is one of many energy initiatives that UNHCR is implementing as part of its Global Strategy for Safe Access to Fuel and Energy (SAFE) 2014-2018.

Carbon financing is an innovative funding tool that places a financial value on carbon emissions and allows companies wishing to offset their own emissions to buy carbon credits earned from sustainable projects. This allows for the financing of innovative projects that bring sustainable energy solutions to people living in developing countries worldwide – in this case, refugees and other persons of concern to UNHCR. For UNHCR, this provides a means of increasing the use of fuel-efficient stoves which can help reduce tensions between refugees and host communities over competition for scarce natural resources, and the risk of respiratory infections caused by indoor air pollution.

Emergency Information Management Toolkit

Using advanced technology and simple systems to gather data and information on the populations we serve

In January 2015, DPSM'S Field Information and Coordination Support Section (FICSS) released the updated Emergency Information Management Toolkit (Toolkit'), developed as part of the recently completed UNHCR Information & Data Management Strategy 2012-2014. The Toolkit equips UNHCR staff with the tools and guidance needed to ensure consistent, effective information management in emergencies in support of timely and informed operational decision-making. It reinforces predictable information management activities, and is designed to be used by and serve our staff and partners working in emergencies.

The Toolkit is changing the way UNHCR works in emergencies by allowing actors to better plan, target and coordinate assistance in all types of environments, even in complex urban situations. The Toolkit supports field operations in fully assuming the organization's responsibilities for leading and coordinating information management in both refugee and IDP situations. It further strengthens information management as a core responsibility of UNHCR.
