- 2.2 Administrative/Biographical history** UNHCR established an office in Manila in 1975. In November 1979 UNHCR signed an agreement with the Philippine government to open a Refugee Processing Center in Bataan Province for the temporary accommodation of Indo-Chinese refugees.
- 2.4 Immediate source of acquisition** The records were transferred from UNHCR BO Manila to UNHCR Archives in February 1998 following the closure of the Transit Center in Manila in late 1997.
- 3.1 Scope and content** The records consist of individual refugee case files.
