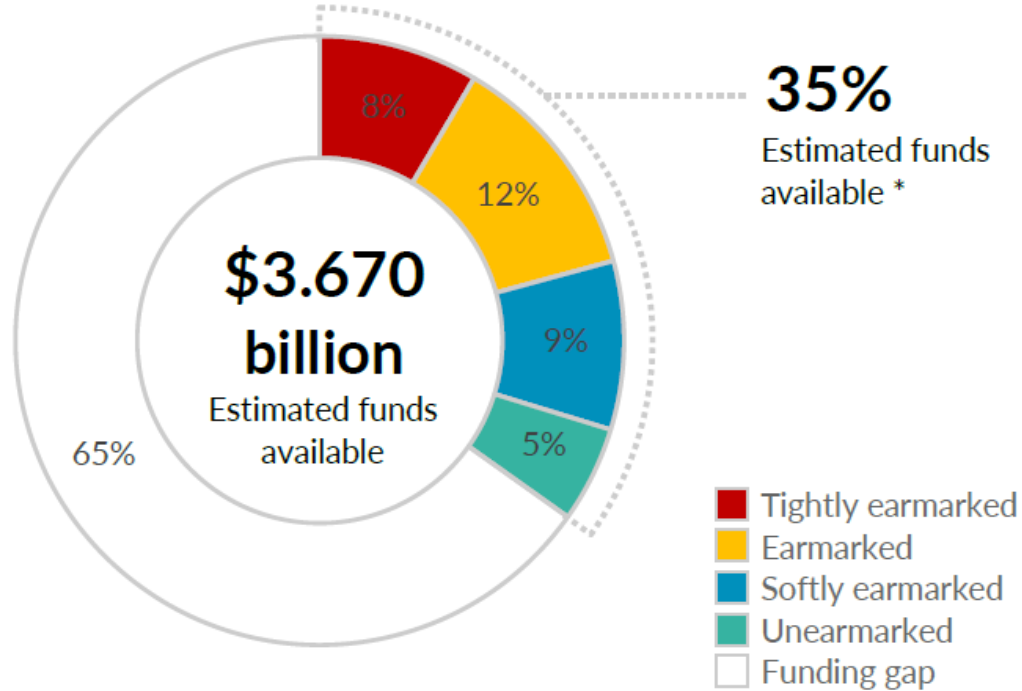

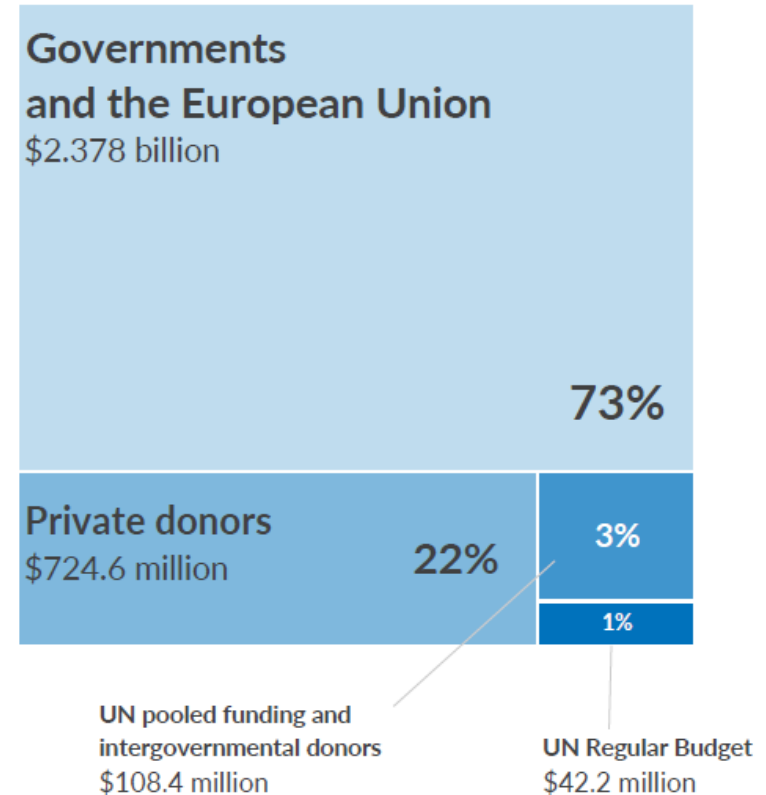

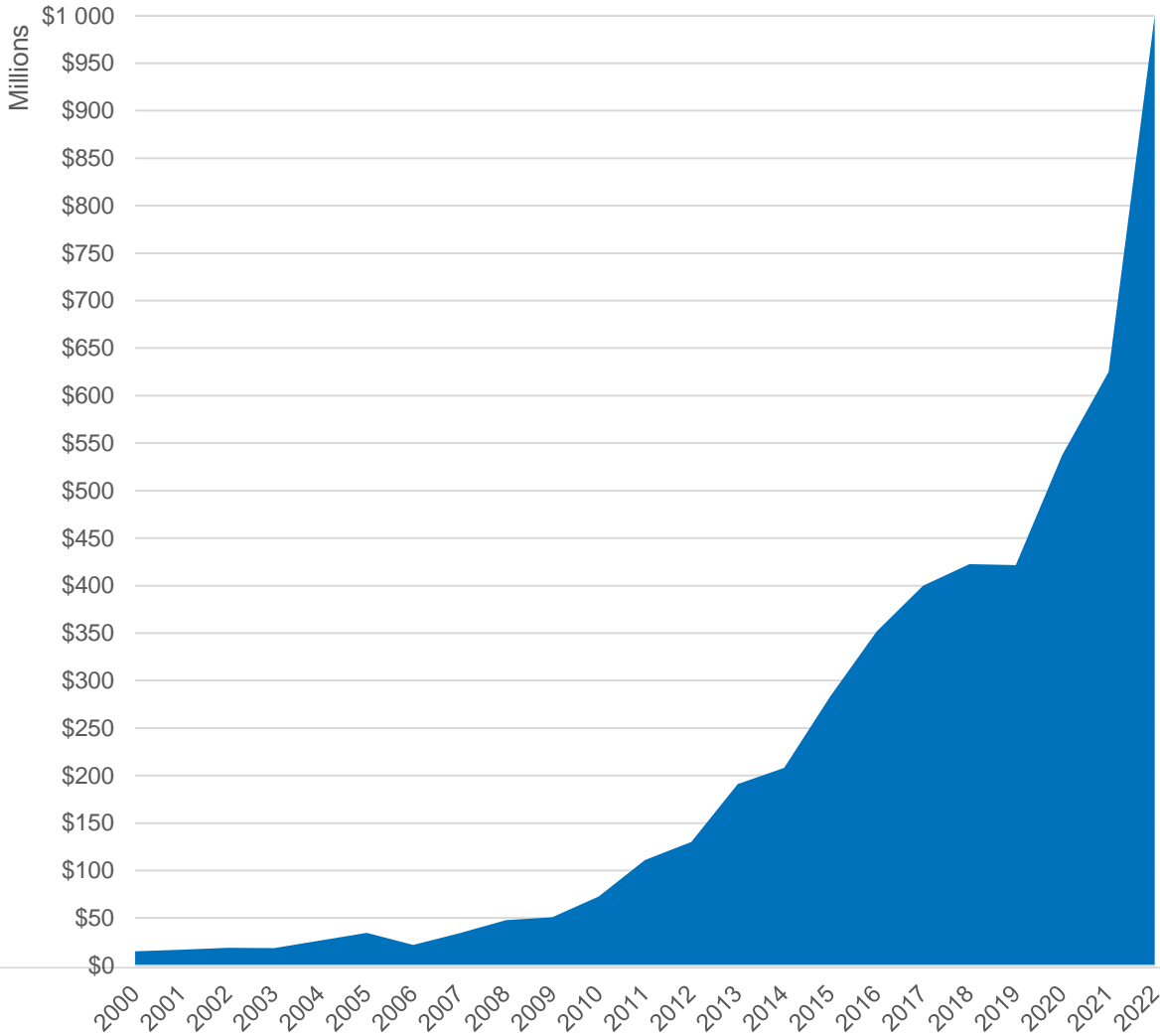
Sources of funding
