WE INFORM



Mass communication and awareness raising on COVID-19 and vaccination

- **100%** of refugees known to UNHCR reached with information on COVID-19 and vaccination through SMS, WhatsApp Communication Tree, social media platforms and website
- **More than 3,680** community members trained and mobilized, among which **709** specifically on vaccination
- **10,470** COVID-19 awareness and information sessions conducted, reaching **193,705 persons**
- **238,489 persons** reached specifically on vaccination awareness by refugee outreach and community health volunteers (OVs and CHVs) and partners through individual remote or physical outreach (phone calls or home visits)

WE SUPPORT



Call center

- **484,024 calls** related to COVID-19 assistance responded to by the joint UNHCR - WFP Call Center¹ since the start of the pandemic



Hygiene kit distributions

- **188,264** hygiene kits distributed in refugee settings (informal settlements, non-residential and collective shelters)², reaching **432,181 persons**



Vaccination enrollment

- **115,279 persons** supported by outreach volunteers for vaccination enrollment on the IMPACT³ platform

WE TREAT



13 hospitals supported with expansion and rehabilitation works, hospital equipment, medical supplies and PPEs, including:

- **586** regular hospital beds
- **100** ICU beds
- **100** stationary and **20** portable ventilators



100% coverage for tests and treatment of refugee patients

- **3,786 COVID-19 tests** covered under UNHCR's referral care programme since the start of the pandemic
- **1,823 refugees** admitted for COVID-19 under UNHCR's referral care programme since the start of the pandemic



3 vaccination sites supported with medical supplies and loan of medical equipment



2 Primary Healthcare Centers (PHC)

in the Bekaa and in the North were supported with construction works and medical supplies, leading to respectively **6,756** and **3,469 doses** vaccinations administered



Mobile vaccination teams deployed in refugee settings in North, Bekaa, South and BML, leading to **27,610 vaccinations administered** with **22,971** being 1st doses and **4,638** 2nd doses

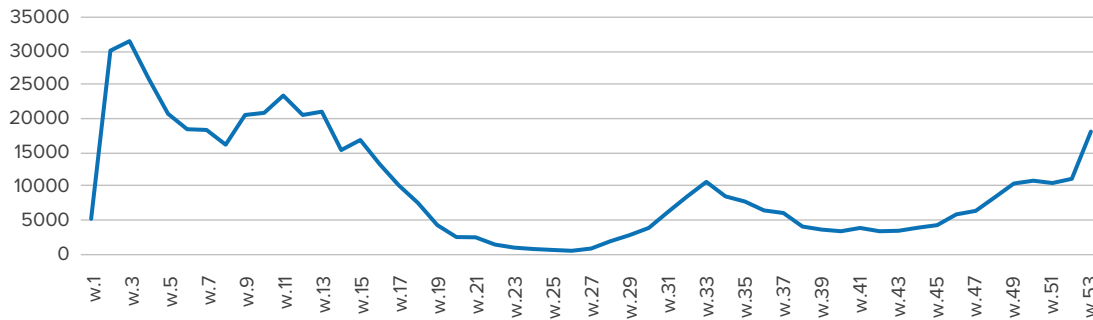

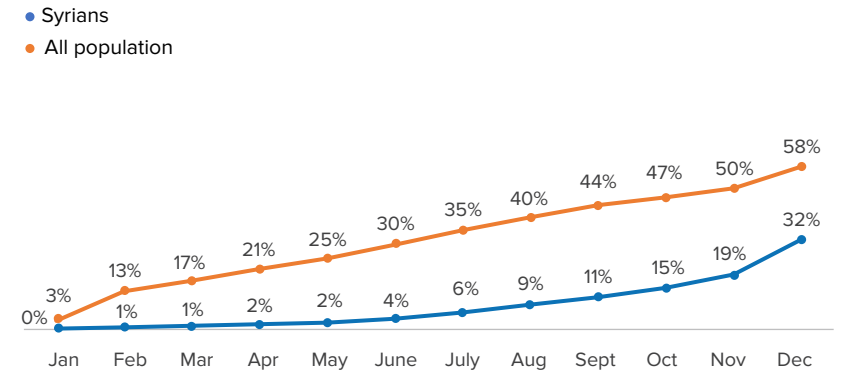

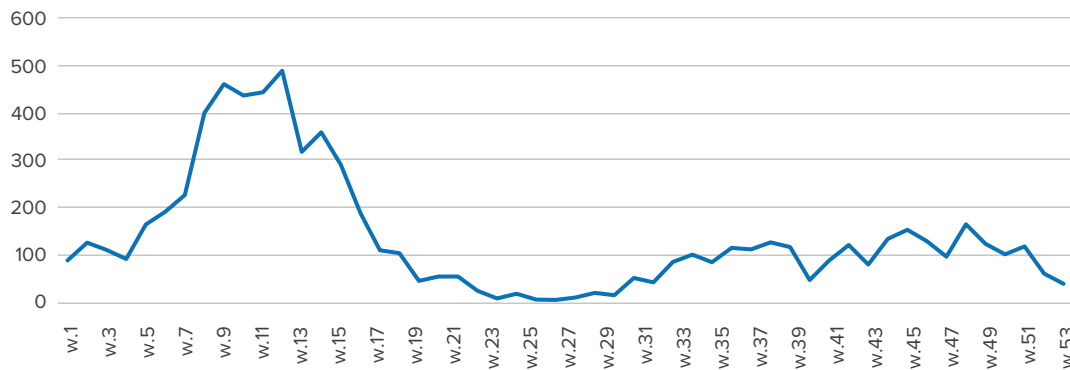
COVID-19 Confirmed cases per week - All Nationalities
