

New System for COVID-19 Vaccination

Update:

Registration for the COVID-19 vaccine is open to people over the age of 40 from 23/04/2020. Registration is done online or by SMS (as explained below).

As of Saturday 10 April 2021, a new system for COVID-19 vaccination came into effect. The new system requires individuals to **register for their vaccine using SMS or an online system.**

Online system:

- Available at the following link: <https://vaccin.gov.mt/>
- Allows you to choose which region in Malta or Gozo you wish to be vaccinated in.

SMS system:

- Send an SMS with your ID card number to +356 99180045 for vaccination in Malta.
- Send an SMS with your ID card number to +356 99180044 for vaccination in Gozo.
- Does not allow you to choose which region to be vaccinated in.

Previously, details on vaccination appointments were being sent in letters by post. **This system will be phased out.**
