

Further Reduction of COVID-19 Measures

As announced by the Maltese Government on 5 August 2021, current restrictions for COVID-19 prevention will be relaxed as follows:

From 16 August 2021:

- Outdoor seated events will be able to host up to 300 people. All attendees would have to be in possession of a vaccine certificate.
- Fully vaccinated people who test negative after contact with COVID-19 cases will need to quarantine for 7 days and not 14 days.

From 30 August 2021:

- Outdoor seated events will be able to host 500 people. All attendees would have to be in possession of a vaccine certificate.

From 6 September 2021:

- Fully vaccinated people will be allowed to attend standing events like concerts and parties. The events will be limited to up to 100 people.

Reminder

Wearing a mask is mandatory in all indoor public spaces such as shops, as well as on public transport.

Standing events such as parties, remain prohibited until 6 September.

Public gatherings remain limited to groups of 6 people for the time being.
