

COVID-19 Vaccine Certificate Validity – January 2022

As from 17 January 2022, new regulations have been put into place regarding the validity of COVID-19 vaccination certificates.

Adults aged 18 years and over

- **With two doses of the vaccine:** the certificate will be valid for 3 months since the second dose. *If the person was administered the Johnson & Johnson vaccine, the **single dose** will be considered valid.*
- **With three doses of the vaccine (two main doses plus booster dose):** the certificate will be valid for 9 months since the third dose. A **single dose plus the booster dose** will be considered valid if the person was originally administered the Johnson & Johnson vaccine.

Children aged 12-17 years

- The certificate will be valid if two doses of the vaccine have been administered.
