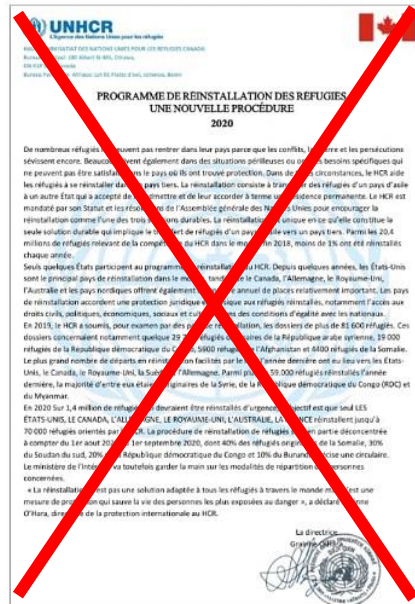


IMPORTANT!

UNHCR is aware of several scams targeting refugees. Refugees are defrauded into believing they may be selected for resettlement as part of a United Nations Global Humanitarian scheme. To add legitimacy to the scam, clients are being sent official looking documents on **counterfeit** UN letterheads.



Be aware of **fake** organizations claiming to be affiliated to the UN fraudulently promising resettlement opportunities and persuading people to part with their money or any sort of favor(s) in order to assist you to get to a resettlement country.
