Report of the Standing Committee on its eighty-sixth meeting (7-9 March 2023)

I. Introduction

1. The Standing Committee of the Executive Committee of the High Commissioner's Programme (Executive Committee) held its eighty-sixth meeting at the International Conference Centre Geneva from 7 to 9 March 2023.

2. The First Vice-Chairperson of the Executive Committee, Permanent Representative of Germany to the United Nations Office at Geneva, opened the eighty-sixth meeting of the Standing Committee. The Second Vice-Chairperson of the Executive Committee, Permanent Representative of Ecuador to the United Nations Office at Geneva, assisted in the chairing of the meeting.

3. New requests for observer status were approved for the following States: Central African Republic (the), Dominican Republic (the), El Salvador, Equatorial Guinea, Gabon, Gambia (the), Liberia, Niger (the) and Sierra Leone. Including those approved at the seventy-third session of the Executive Committee in October 2022,¹ this brought the total number of Standing Committee observer States for the period October 2022 to October 2023 to 16.²

11. The Standing Committee work programme for 2023, as discussed at the planning meeting held in December 2022 and as contained in annex I, was adopted as presented.

IV. Work of the eighty-sixth meeting of the Standing Committee

12. The Deputy High Commissioner delivered an opening statement. The Assistant High Commissioner (Operations) then provided an overview of the challenges and opportunities facing UNHCR operations in the seven regions under its organizational structure and highlighted advances in key programmatic areas.

13. Presentations under each agenda item were made by senior management of UNHCR, and Executive Committee members and Standing Committee observers were given the opportunity to make comments and ask questions. V. Decisions of the Standing Committee of the Executive Committee of the High Commissioner's Programme

A. Programme of the Office of the United Nations High Commissioner for Refugees (UNHCR) in the Secretary-General's proposed programme budget for 2024

14. The Standing Committee,

Takes note of part VI, section 25, programme 21: International protection, durable solutions and assistance to refugees of the United Nations proposed programme budget for 2024.

B. Decision on budgets and funding for 2022 and 2023

15. The Standing Committee,

Recalling the Executive Committee's decisions at its seventy-third session on administrative, financial and programme matters (A/77/12/Add.1, para. 13(c)) as well as its discussions under the programme budgets and funding item at the eighty-fifth meeting of the Standing Committee in September 2022,

Reaffirming the importance of greater responsibility-sharing in solidarity with countries hosting refugees,

Recalls that the Executive Committee, at its seventy-second session, approved original programmes and budgets for regional programmes, global programmes and headquarters under the UNHCR 2022 annual programme budget, amounting to \$8,993.7 million,

Notes that the final 2022 supplementary budgets amounted to \$1,720.3 million for programmes benefiting the UNHCR programmes and projects,

Takes note of the increase in the UNHCR annual budget for 2022 to a final total of \$10,714.0 million, representing the sum of the original budget of \$8,993.7 million and the final supplementary budgets of \$1,720.3 million,

Recalls that the Executive Committee, at its seventy-third session in October 2022, approved original programmes and budgets for regional programmes, global programmes

and headquarters under the UNHCR 2023 annual programme budget, amounting to \$10,211.3 million (A/AC.96/1224),

Takes note of the increase in the UNHCR annual budget for 2023 at a current total of \$10,417.1 million as of 31 January 2023, representing the sum of the original budget of \$10,211.3 million, supplementary budgets of \$305.8 million and a budget reduction of \$100.0 million,

Recognizes that emergencies and unforeseen activities unfolding in 2023 may result in the need for additional or expanded supplementary budgets and that additional resources, over and above those for existing budgets, would be needed to meet such needs, and

Urges Member States to continue to respond generously, in the spirit of solidarity and in a timely manner, to the High Commissioner's appeal for resources to meet in full the annual budget for 2023.
