Balancing the urgent need for short-term, life-saving interventions with the imperative to invest in longer-term, sustainable approaches presents a difficult and often painful dilemma. In an era of shrinking resources, these compromises are becoming increasingly stark — particularly in contexts of protracted displacement. At this pivotal moment, it is essential to advance locally-led action and promote commitments to more inclusive and accountable humanitarian responses. In a broader context where refugee protection is being undermined and the asylum space under threat, finding collective ways forward is more urgent than ever. This NGO-led side event will highlight how refugee leaders are redefining localization in practice — moving beyond participation toward transformative leadership. The panel will share lessons learned and explore how to scale these approaches in a context where the global humanitarian landscape is undergoing a profound shift and critical conversations are taking place within the framework of the Humanitarian Reset, the UN80 process and broader system reform efforts.
