The conflict in Sudan between the Sudanese Armed Forces and the Rapid Support Forces started on **15 April 2023**. This dashboard gives an overview of arrivals and registration trends in Egypt since the onset of the conflict.

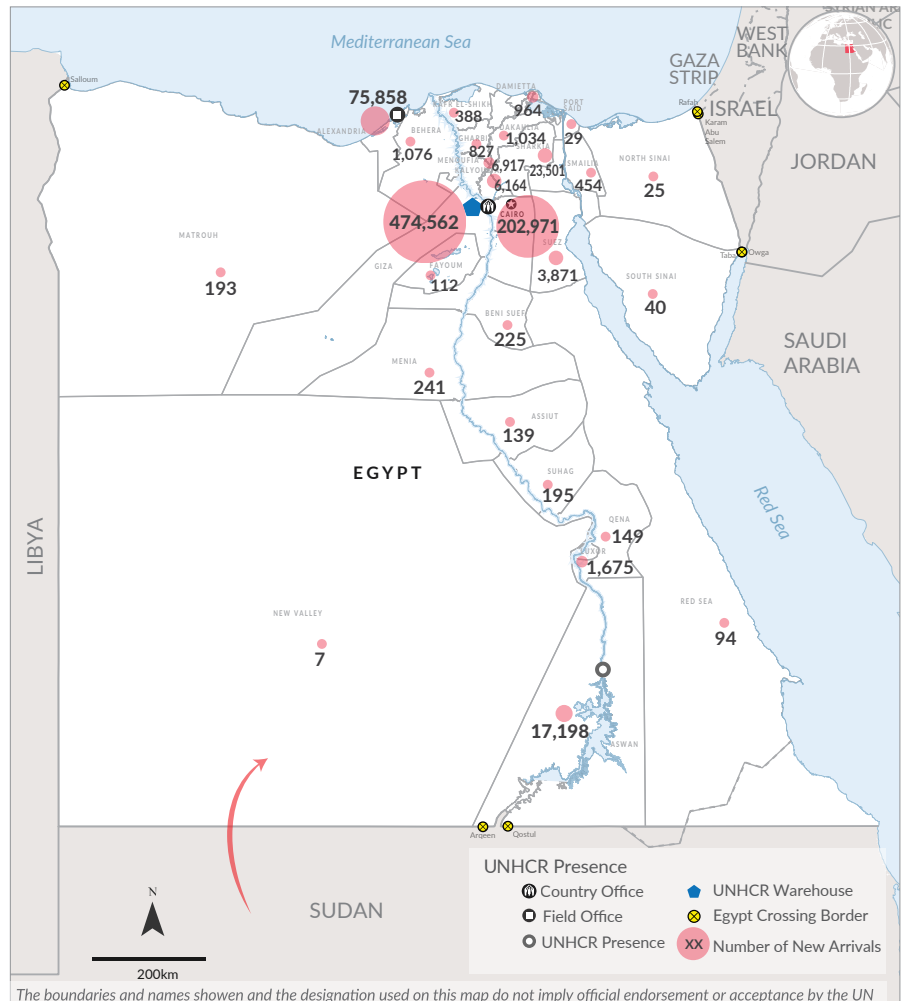
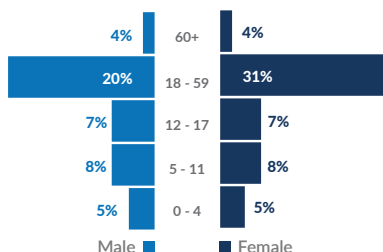
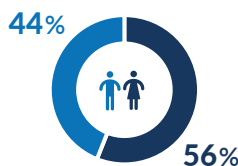
