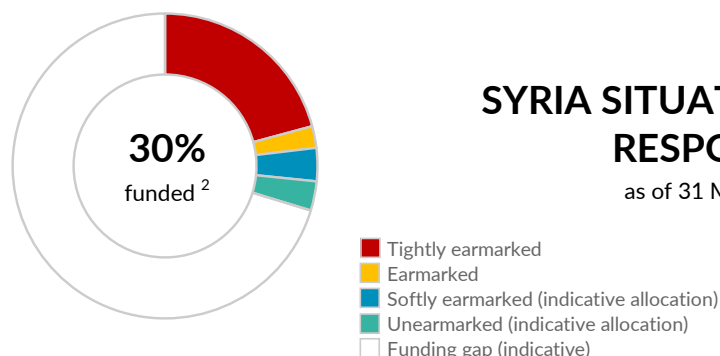

Methodology: Flexible and country-level funding is allocated and reallocated multiple times during the year to allow UNHCR to fund prioritised activities. This funding update includes an indicative allocation of funds so as to accurately represent the resources available for the situation. The contributions earmarked for Syria Situation Response shown above are combined with an indicative allocation of the earmarked, softly earmarked, and unearmarked contributions listed below. This allocation respects different levels of earmarking. Adjustments relate to indirect support costs and carry-over.

Notes:

1. The financial requirements of the Syria Situation Response include requirements in Egypt, Iraq, Jordan, Lebanon, Syrian Arab Republic and Türkiye.
2. The percentage funded (30%) and total funding amount (\$375,555,366) are indicative based on the methodology described above. This leaves an indicative funding gap of \$888,216,069 representing 70% of the financial requirements.
3. Contributions to the Syria Situation Response are shown by the earmarking modality as defined in the Grand Bargain.
4. Due to their earmarking at a related region, sub-region, country or theme, the other softly earmarked contributions listed are those which can potentially be used for the Syria Situation Response. Where a donor has contributed \$2 million or more, the total amount of the contribution is shown.
5. Contributed without restrictions on its use, unearmarked funding allows UNHCR critical flexibility in how best to reach refugees and other populations of concern who are in the greatest need and at the greatest risk. Where a donor has contributed \$10 million or more, the total amount of the contribution is shown.
