June 20	Liechtenstein	As of June 20, 500 pupils in Liechtenstein will be sending written suggestions for improving the refugee situation in Liechtenstein wide range of personalities and relatives.
June 25	Musée Ariana  THE NANSEN  REFUGEE  AWARD	The 2003 Nansen Refugee Award ceremony will be held in Geneva at the Musée Ariana. This year the award is given to Dr. Annalena Tonelli. July 1	Liechtenstein	On July first, the inauguration of the "kids guernica" will take place. A moving exhibition will be on display with drawings done by children on the theme of peace. The chief of government of Liechtenstein and Olivier Delarue will be delivering speeches for the celebration of the World Refugee Day 2003.
