## Populations of concern to UNHCR in 2004

Country or territory of asylum or residence. In the absence of government estimates, UNHCR has estimated the refugee population in most industrialized countries, based on recent refugee arrivals and recognition rates of asylum-seekers. For Canada, USA, Australia and New Zealand, estimates are based on arrivals/recognition rates over the past five years, whereas for most European countries a 10-year period has been applied because these periods reflect the different naturalization rates for refugees in these regions. Notes:

1. Data for industrialized countries have not been updated; data for end-2003 is used as an estimate.
