CHAPTER IV

DEMOGRAPHIC CHARACTERISTICS AND LOCATION

INTRODUCTION

Information on the gender, age and location of refugees is essential for planning, implementing, monitoring and evaluating refugee programmes. In particular, UNHCR policy priorities of gender equity, children and adolescents and older refugees require the availability of gender and age profiles.

In 2003, demographic data was reported by 79 per cent of the countries covering about 51 per cent of the total population of concern to UNHCR. Most demographic information is available from countries where UNHCR has an operational role. The 31 countries for which no gender or age breakdown are available are mostly industrialized countries where Governments are responsible for data collection.

The absence of refugee statistics by gender and age in most industrialized countries affects not only programme planning, but also skews the global demographic profile. With the industrialized countries underrepresented, UNHCR statistics show a relatively high presence of children and few older refugees.

UNHCR projects often target beneficiaries at the local level. Therefore, the 2003 Yearbook provides information disaggregated at the camp level as well as for urban locations.

GENDER AND AGE

Of the more than 8.7 million persons of concern to UNHCR for whom information by gender was reported in 2003, 4.2 million (48%) are women of all ages (see *Map 6*).

The proportion of females is around 50 per cent for most age groups. Girls constitute 49 per cent of the children under five and 48 per cent of those aged 5 to 17 years. Among the population aged 18 to 59, 47 per cent are women. The overrepresentation of women among refugees aged 60 and over (53%) reflects the higher life expectancy of women in general.

As noted, the 7.5 million persons for whom age information was reported tend to be young. Some 46 per cent are under the age of 18, while 13 per cent are under five years of age. Seven per cent are aged 60 or over (see Table IV.1).

Women constitute between 45 and 55 per cent of the population of concern to UNHCR in most regions. The low proportion of women in Latin America and the Caribbean (41%) is due to the fact that the statistical information was reported for only three per cent of the population of concern to UNHCR, most of whom are asylum-seekers and refugees in urban areas.

The high birth rates reported by developing countries are also reflected in UNHCR's demographic statistics. The proportion of children under the age of 18 is the highest in Africa (54%), but also significant in Oceania (48%) and Asia (46%).

In contrast, the proportion of children in Europe (25%) and Latin America and the Caribbean (20%) is limited, reflecting the lower birth rates prevalent in these regions. In addition, the low proportion of children in some countries reflects age-selective refugee movements to urban locations and industrialized countries.

The above patterns are confirmed for children below five years of age. The proportion of young children varies from 19 per cent in Africa and 12 per cent in Asia and Oceania, to only three per cent in Europe and Latin America and the Caribbean.


Countries with low birth rates tend to have a high proportion of older persons. This demographic process, referred to as ageing, is also reflected in the refugee population. The proportion of refugees aged 60 years and over is significant in Europe (18%), but still low in Africa and Oceania (4%).

LOCATION

UNHCR beneficiary programmes are normally implemented at the field level. A key factor in every project is the settlement pattern of the beneficiaries: are refugees living in camps, in urban areas or in rural areas among the local population?

In 2003, the type of location was reported for some 13.1 million persons of concern to UNHCR in 125 mainly non-industrialized countries. Of these, 4.7 million persons were residing in camps or centres (36%), 2.0 million persons (15%) were living in urban areas, whereas 6.5 million persons (49%) were either living in rural areas among the local population or their type of settlement was unknown.

Almost half of all camp residents live in countries covered by UNHCR's Africa Bureau (47%). The CASWANAME region hosts the second largest camp population (33%), followed by Europe (12%) and Asia and the Pacific (8%). As noted, industrialized countries, where asylum-seekers are often hosted in reception or detention centres are generally not included in these data.



In Africa, the population of concern to UNHCR is twice as likely to live in camps (60%) than in Asia (34%). In 30 countries, 50 per cent or more of the population of concern to UNHCR was reported to be living in camps or centres.

In 2003, UNHCR received information on over 300 locations classified as camps or centers. The precise number of refugee camps is difficult to establish. Should it have a minimum size or population density? Should camps have а clearly marked perimeter? Should detention centres, transit centres, collective centres and settlements be considered as camps? Reliable camp statistics may not always be available due to lack of UNHCR access or presence.

In 2003, the average camp size was around 10,000 residents with a large variation in population size. Some 83 camps had fewer than 1,000 residents, while 93 camps hosted over 10,000 residents.

Urban locations are considerably smaller than camps or centers. The 285 urban locations where UNHCR carried out protection or assistance activities hosted on average 3,100 persons of concern to UNHCR. Some 214 urban locations (75%) hosted fewer than 1,000 persons, while half of the urban locations hosted fewer than 100 persons.

Data from major refugee camps and settlements covering the period 2001-2003 indicate that most refugee camps have a balanced sex ratio. In 88 per cent of the major refugee camps, the proportion of females was between 45 and 55 per cent. Camps located in developing countries have a high proportion of children. In contrast, camps in more developed countries host fewer children, but more ageing refugees. In sum, the demographic structure of refugees closely resembles that of nationals (see Table IV.2).
