Who is a refugee?

Someone who flees his or her country because of well founded fear of persecution. Today, UNHCR cares for 20.8 million people in 117 countries: refugees, internally displaced persons, returnees, asylum seekers and other categories. Nine million of them are refugee youth who need your help. The figures here illustrate the severity of the problem.

UNHCR has counted 20.8 million refugees worldwide, of which:

- 9,022,778 are children
- 2,053,100 are "stateless people"
- 839,200 are "asylum seekers" who have fled their own country for fear of persecution
