


At year end

At the end of 2014, almost 55 million people depended on the protection and assistance of UNHCR and partners. They include:

Afghanistan

805,000 people remain internally displaced.

Central African Republic (CAR)

426,000 CAR refugees in the region; 438,000 people remain internally displaced.

Democratic Republic of the Congo (DRC)

2.7 million people remain internally displaced.

Europe

European sea arrivals at record high. Over 207,000 people reached Europe by sea - almost three times the previous high of 70,000 in 2011 (during the Libyan civil war); some 3,500 people died or are reported missing attempting to cross the Mediterranean Sea.

Iraq

369,000 Iraqi refugees; 3.59 million people remain internally displaced.

Libya

363,000 people remain internally displaced.

Nigeria

54,000 Nigerian refugees; 1.1 million people remain internally displaced.

Pakistan

300,000 refugees from North Waziristan in Afghanistan; 1.3 million people remain internally displaced.

South Sudan

488,000 South Sudanese refugees displaced across the region (70% children); 1.6 million people remain internally displaced.

Syrian Arab Republic (Syria)

3.7 million Syrian refugees in the region; estimated 12.2 million people in need of humanitarian assistance inside Syria; 7.6 million people remain internally displaced.

Ukraine

600,000 Ukrainians have sought asylum or other forms of legal stay in neighbouring countries; 823,000 people remain internally displaced.
