Refugee Status Determination (RSD)

- Preparation workshops for first instance RSD interviews
- Assistance or advice on writing an appeal to UNHCR for those rejected as a refugee
- Assistance or advice on requests for reopening for those with closed UNHCR files

Resettlement

- Recognized refugees in Cairo with a blue card
- Self-referrals accepted twice per year for one month
- Based on self-referral form, RLAP may conduct a needs assessment. Not everyone who submits a self-referral is granted an RLAP interview.
- Referral to UNHCR for resettlement consideration for those who are eligible under UNHCR guidelines
- UNHCR and resettlement countries make the final decision about resettlement.
- Resettlement is *not* a right. Less than 1% of refugees are resettled.
