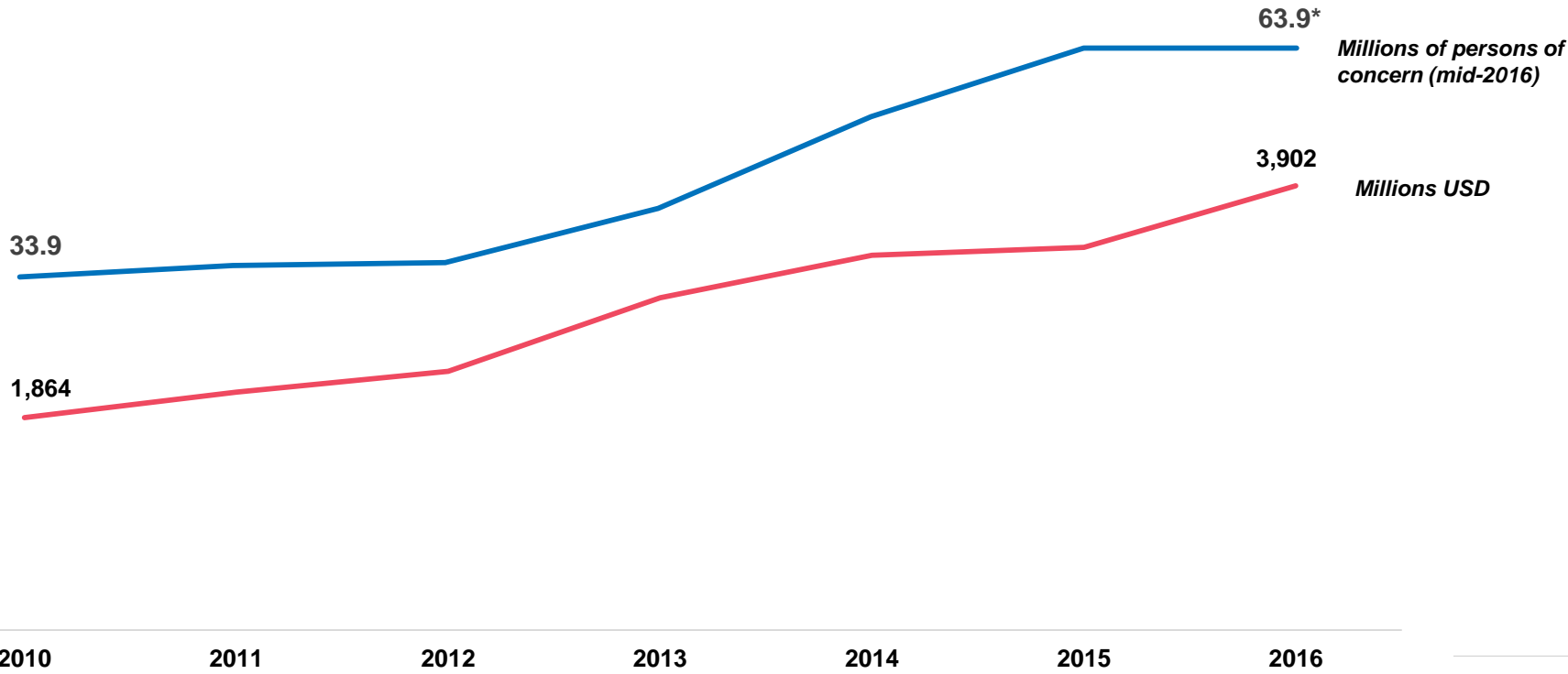

5.1 million persons were not assisted with core relief items



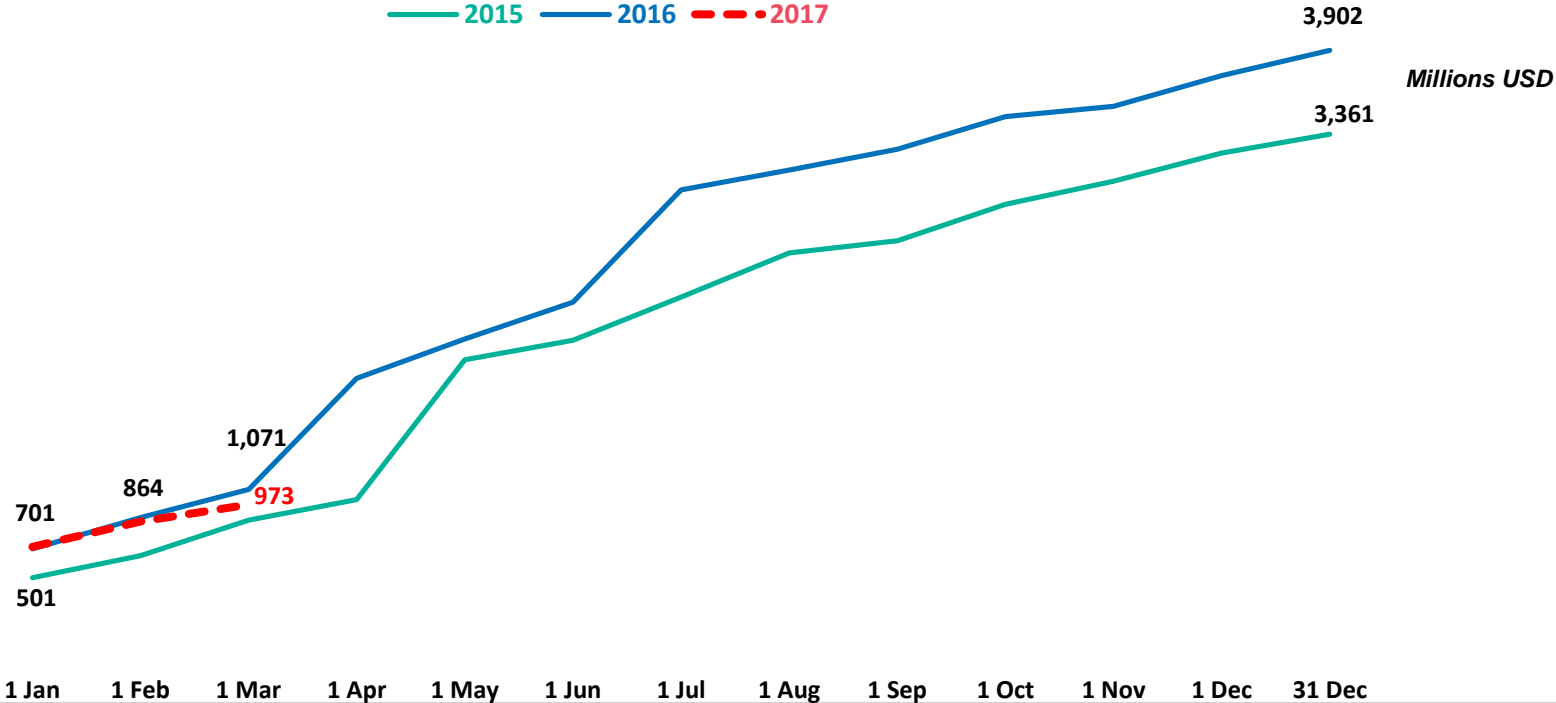
641,000 women and girls
were not assisted with sanitary materials



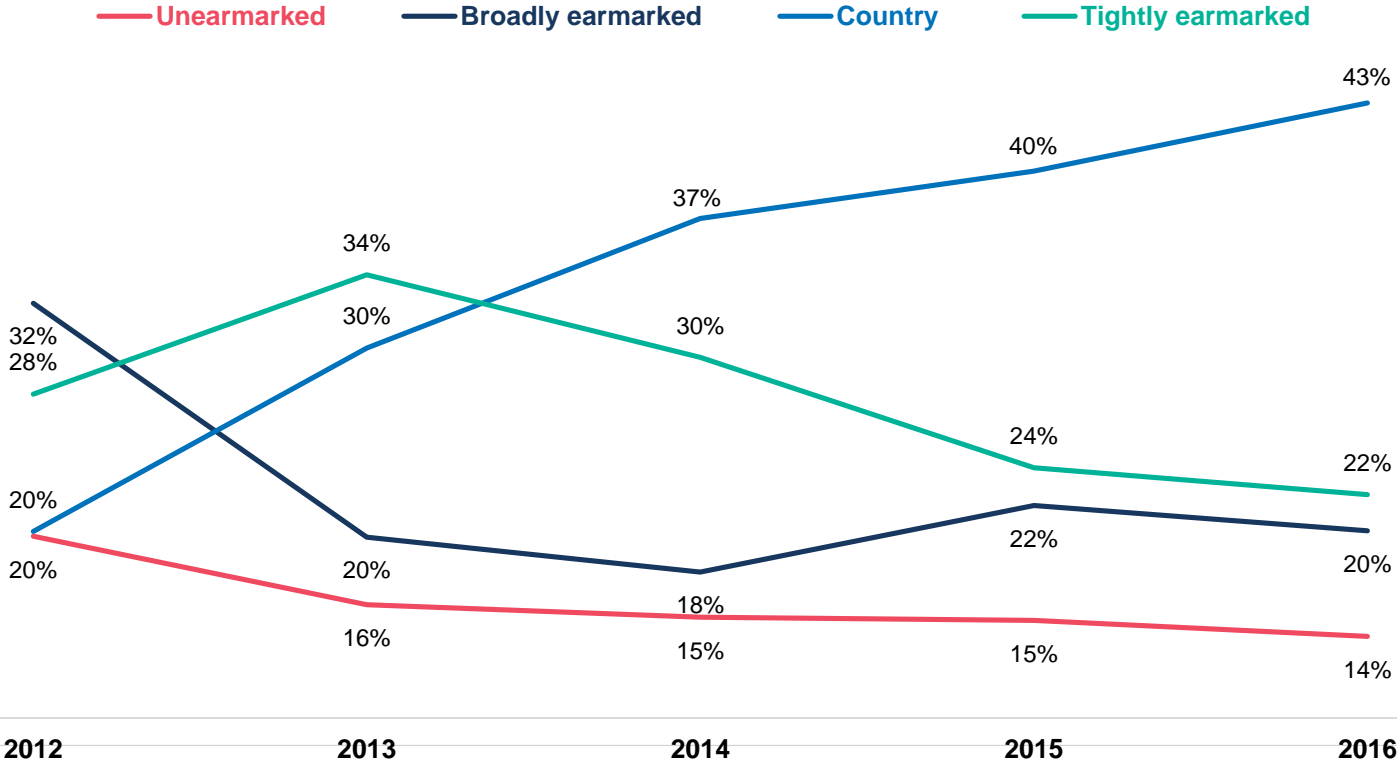
418,000 children were not enrolled
in primary education



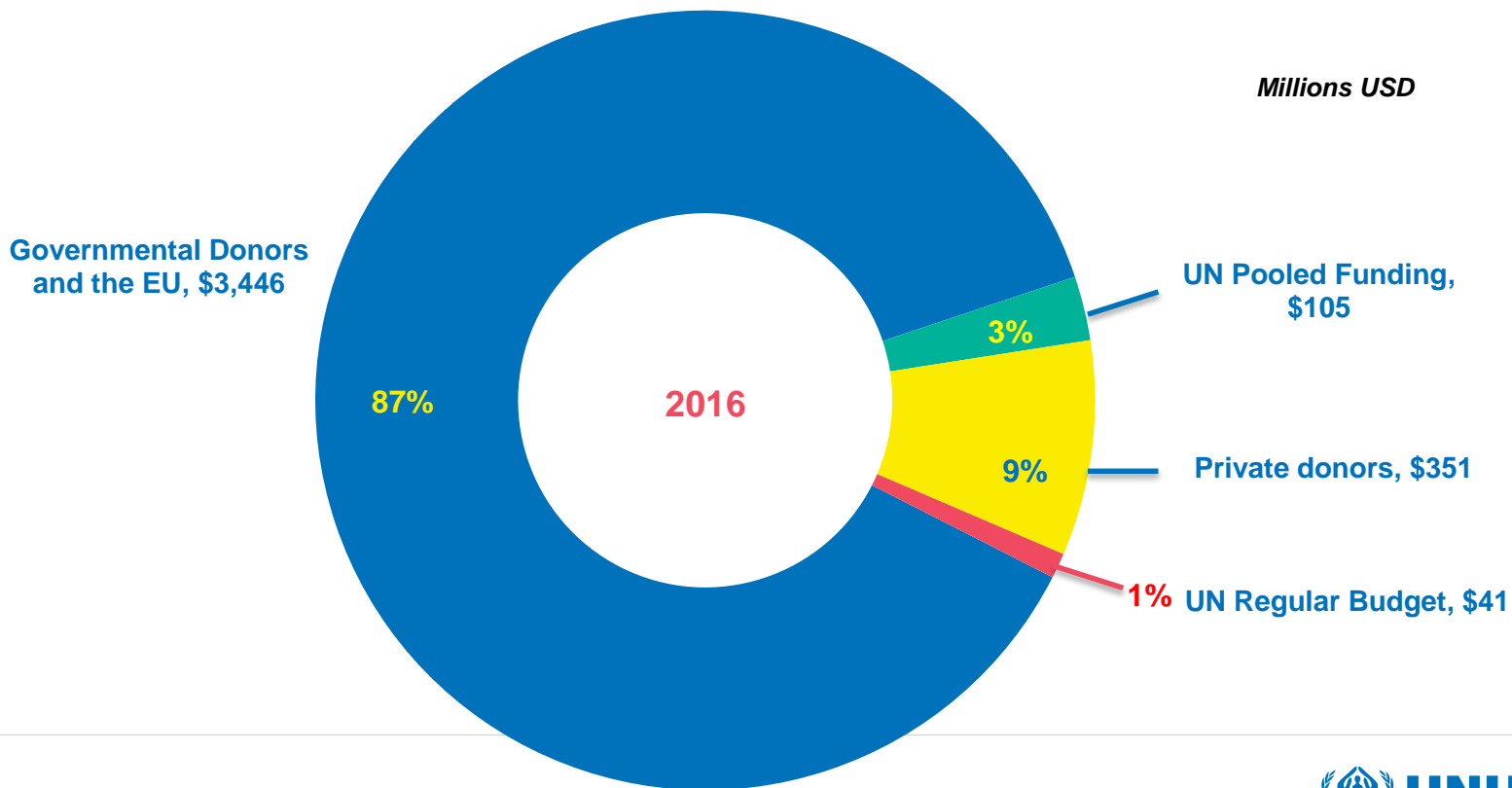

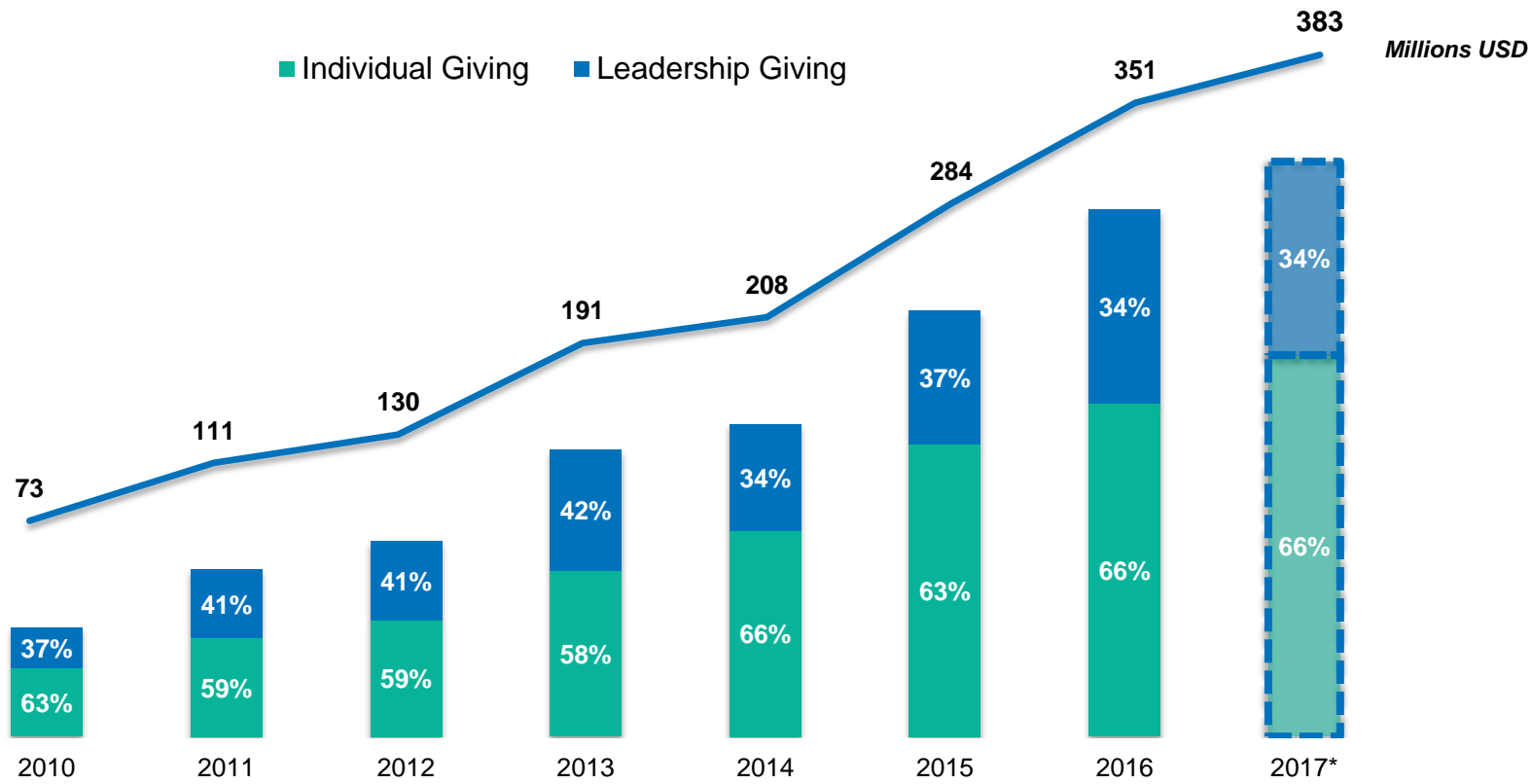

Example of donor visibility for cash programme in Jordan

CASH ASSISTANCE IN NUMBERS (individuals)



Monthly cash assistance

Provided to the most vulnerable refugee households based on individual needs and family size.

Winterization

Provided to help protect persons of concern from the many challenges presented by the colder weather.

Emergency support

One-off assistance provided on an exceptional basis when a household faces a emergency such as urgent medical care or eviction.

I miss everything about Syria. Everything. My family, the life we once had. I can't believe we have ended like this. UNHCR cash assistance is the only thing that keeps a roof over our heads.
