Since the launch of the #IBelong campaign to end statelessness in November 2014, States have granted nationality to thousands of stateless individuals and have implemented legislative reforms to prevent statelessness and better identify stateless persons. Civil society groups have also helped raise awareness of the statelessness cause and encouraged law reforms, and regional bodies have spearheaded initiatives that have led to the adoption of declarations and action plans to eradicate statelessness. This side event will showcase some of these efforts to build momentum ahead of the High-Level Event in October 2019, which will mark the mid-point of the #IBelong Campaign.
