The side event will focus on Jordan and Lebanon's response to the huge influx of refugees from the Syrian Arab Republic, providing protection and assistance, while expanding the capacity of their national systems to help both their own nationals and refugees. The panel will highlight best practices in government-led initiatives and programmes, including the recently issued Regional Refugee and Resilience Response Plan (3RP), the Jordan Response Plan (JRP) and the Lebanon Crisis Response Plan (LCRP). Looking to the future, the panel will also consider how refugees' access to national systems and services have helped build their human capital during the years in exile, and how this could eventually enable refugees to re-establish and rebuild their lives in the Syrian Arab Republic. An overview of resettlement to third countries and the opportunities for voluntary, safe and dignified return of Syrian refugees will also be provided.
