


#### 2019 Funds available



Amounts in USD millions




#### Most underfunded situations


 Several governments have contributed more to UNHCR in 2019 than they did to this date last year:







## Private sector income | 2012-2019




#### Potential of Islamic philanthropy


- Help the most vulnerable displaced communities around the world

- Zakat funds solicited by UNHCR since 2016 are earmarked for cash-based interventions




