Item 3 General debate

The general debate is articulated around issues raised in the statement of the High Commissioner. The Committee will have received an outline of the High Commissioner's statement in advance of the session. The Committee will also have before it brief updates on developments at the regional and global levels. The list of speakers for the general debate will be opened on Monday, 7 September 2020.

- (v) the multi-year workplan for executive Committee conclusions for 2021-2022.
