Update on budgets and funding (2022)

Summary

In October 2021, at its seventy-second plenary session, the Executive Committee of the High Commissioner's Programme approved the original annual budget of \$8,993.7 million for 2022. As of 31 July 2022, a total of three supplementary budgets, amounting to \$1,710.3 million, has been established in support of the Afghanistan, Cameroon and Ukraine situations.

This brought the total budget for 2022 to \$10,704.0 million at 31 July 2022, the cut-off date for this report, and a total of \$4,393.4 million in voluntary contributions was recorded for the budget year 2022.

A draft decision on budgets and funding for 2022 is provided in annex VII.

I. Introduction

1. The present document provides an update on UNHCR's requirements and funding for 2022 at 31 July 2022. It should be noted that all income and expenditure amounts are expressed on a modified cash basis.¹

- The original and current budget and interim expenditure for 2022 are summarized in annex I.
- Annex II provides the lists of transfers from the 2022 operational reserve.
- Annex III shows the supplementary budgets by impact area established for 2022.
- Annex IV shows contributions recorded for the budget year 2022.

- Annex VI provides the list of unearmarked and softly earmarked voluntary contributions to UNHCR.

II. Update on budgets and funding for 2022

Original and current budget

2. The original annual budget for 2022 was approved by the Executive Committee at its seventy-second plenary session in October 2021 in the amount of \$8,993.7 million.²

3. In 2022, three supplementary budgets, which were approved by the High Commissioner, amounted to 1,710.3 million at 31 July 2022, the cut-off date for the data used in this report. This brought the total for the 2022 current budget to 10,704.0 million.³

Supplementary budgets

4. In June 2022, at the eighty-fourth meeting of the Standing Committee, a total budget of \$10,534.0 million was reported at 30 April 2022. This included three supplementary budgets established in the amount of \$1,540.3, in support of the Afghanistan, Cameroon and Ukraine situations. Subsequently, the supplementary budget for the Ukraine situation was revised with an additional amount of \$170.0 million, resulting in a current total budget for 2022 of \$10,704.0 at 31 July 2022. A breakdown of 2022 supplementary budgets by situation, region and impact area is presented in annex III.

5. In Afghanistan, UNHCR and partners continue to provide life-saving assistance, such as food and agriculture support, cash-based assistance, emergency shelter, water and sanitation, protection, support for education and community programming. In the Cameroon situation, UNHCR continues to deliver humanitarian assistance, including water and sanitation, shelter, core relief items, protection, as well as life-saving response to survivors of gender-based violence, and support for registration and education. The additional supplementary budget for the Ukraine situation reflects requirements for the UNHCR response in the areas of protection, multipurpose cash assistance and shelter, as well as for winterization.

Transfers and other adjustments

6. In addition to the 2022 supplementary budgets, the current annual budget for 2022 incorporates transfers from the operational reserve, as well as other internal adjustments made by the High Commissioner, in accordance with article 7.4 of the UNHCR financial rules. As shown in annex II, there has been one transfer from the operational reserve.

7. Table II.2 compares requirements for 2022 by region, global programmes and headquarters from end of April to end of July 2022. As shown below, the variance relates to: (a) the additional supplementary budget for the Ukraine situation; and (b) a budget redeployment of \$5.3 million from headquarters to global programmes, reflecting adjustments within divisions based on updated operational requirements.

Comparison of requirements for 2022 by region, global programmes and headquarters *In millions of US dollars*

8. Table II.3 presents the 2022 requirements by impact area. The additional \$170.0 million supplementary budget for the Ukraine situation has been mostly budgeted under impact area 2 (respond), focusing on providing cash assistance, protection services, core relief items, shelter, and expanded reception and collective centre refurbishment for displaced persons. The \$23.6 million, or 1 per cent, decrease under impact area 1 (protect) reflects reprioritization due to evolving operational requirements, mainly in the Americas, Asia, the East and Horn of Africa and Great Lakes, and southern Africa.

10. At 31 July 2022, voluntary contributions of \$4,393.4 million were recorded for the budget year 2022, including \$869.0 million from non-governmental organizations, foundations and private donors (see annexes IV and V). Based on indications from various donors, a further \$835.3 million in voluntary contributions is expected by the end of the year. If this additional funding materializes, the total estimated funds available for the budget year 2022 is anticipated to reach \$5,619.7 million. This amount would include \$42.2 million from the United Nations regular budget, the carry-over of \$235.3 million from 2021, adjustments for voluntary contributions in accordance with their implementation years, as well as other estimated funds and adjustments.

11. In view of the demands placed on the Office, donors are encouraged to continue to respond generously to the High Commissioner's appeal for resources to meet the current annual budget requirements, including through unearmarked funds.

Annex VII

Draft decision on budgets and funding for 2022

The Standing Committee,

Recalling the Executive Committee's decision, at its seventy-second session on administrative, financial and programme matters (A/AC.96/1220, para. 13 (d)), as well as discussions by the Standing Committee on the programme budgets and funding item at its eighty-fourth meeting in June 2022,

Reaffirming the importance of responsibility-sharing in solidarity with countries hosting refugees,

Takes note of the increase in UNHCR's annual budget for 2022 at 31 July 2022 to a current total of \$10,704.0 million, representing the sum of the original budget of \$8,993.7 million and supplementary budgets of \$1,710.3 million,

Recognizes that emergencies and unforeseen activities unfolding in 2022 may result in the need for additional or expanded supplementary budgets and that additional resources, over and above those for existing budgets, would be needed to meet such needs, and

Urges member States to continue to respond generously, in the spirit of solidarity and in a timely manner, to the High Commissioner's appeal for resources to meet in full the annual budget for 2022.
