
# The 2022 High Commissioner's Dialogue on Protection Challenges:

- Preparations for GRF


#### **Outcomes**

### **Protection crosscutting throughout**

- Early action: Enhancing development cooperation to anticipate, respond to, and foster longer-term approaches to displacement
- 2. Inclusion: Strengthening the role of development cooperation in facilitating inclusion in national systems
- 3. Solutions: Unlocking solutions for the displaced through enhanced development cooperation
