







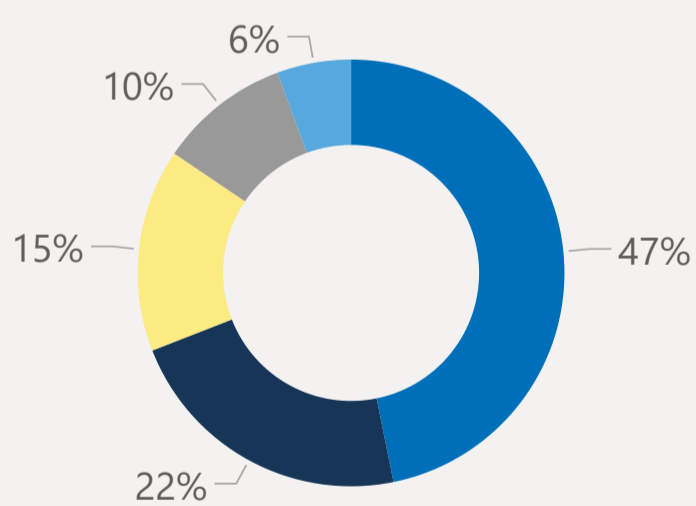

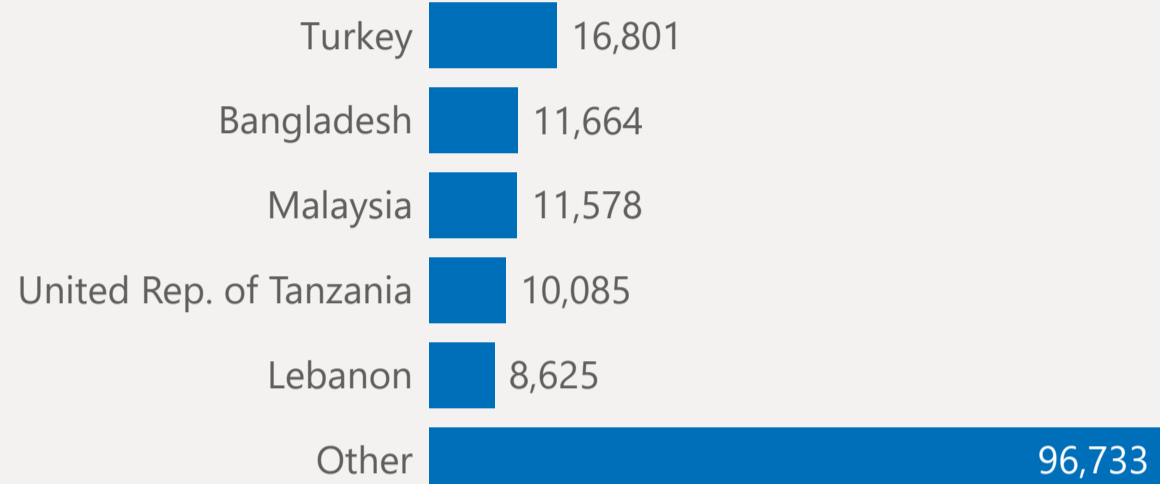

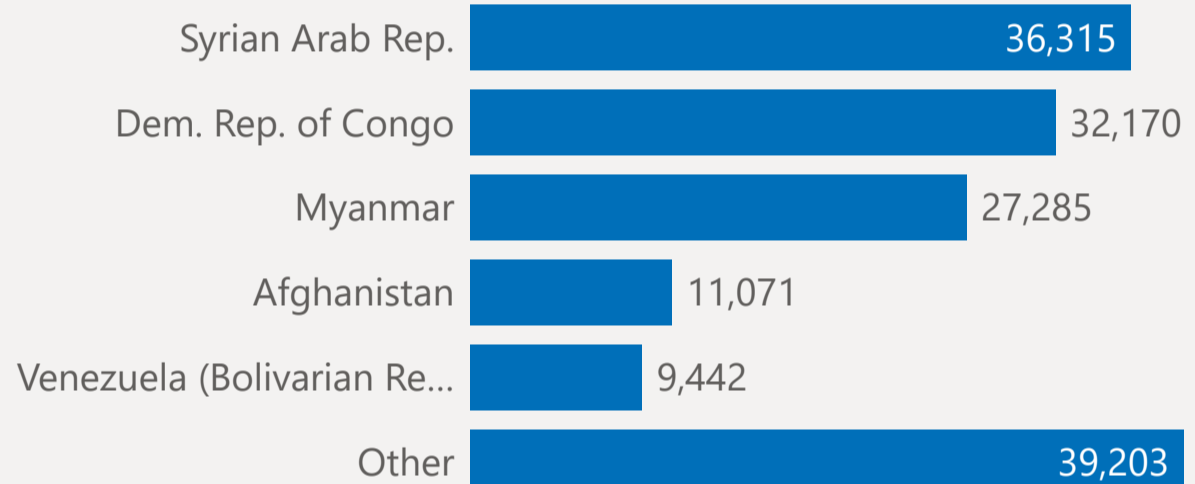

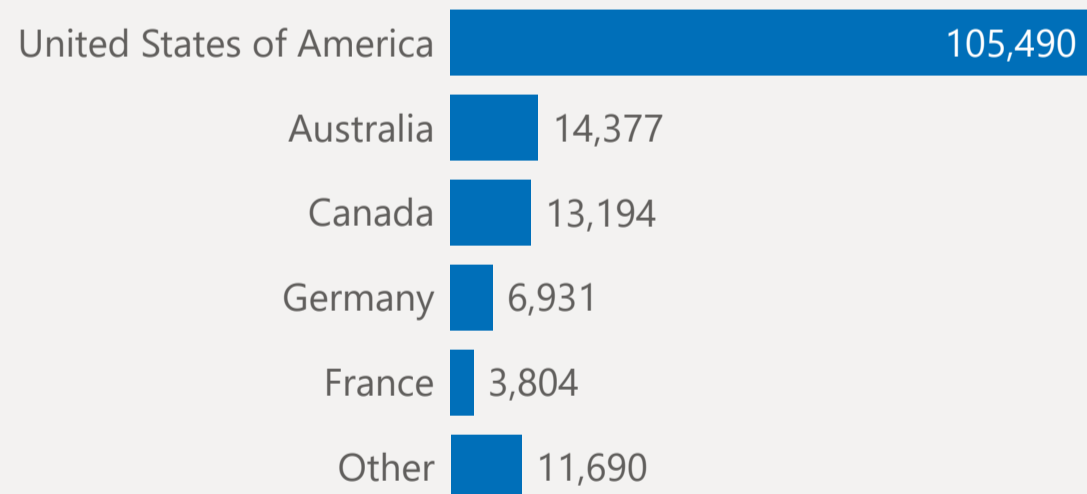
### Submissions by country of asylum
