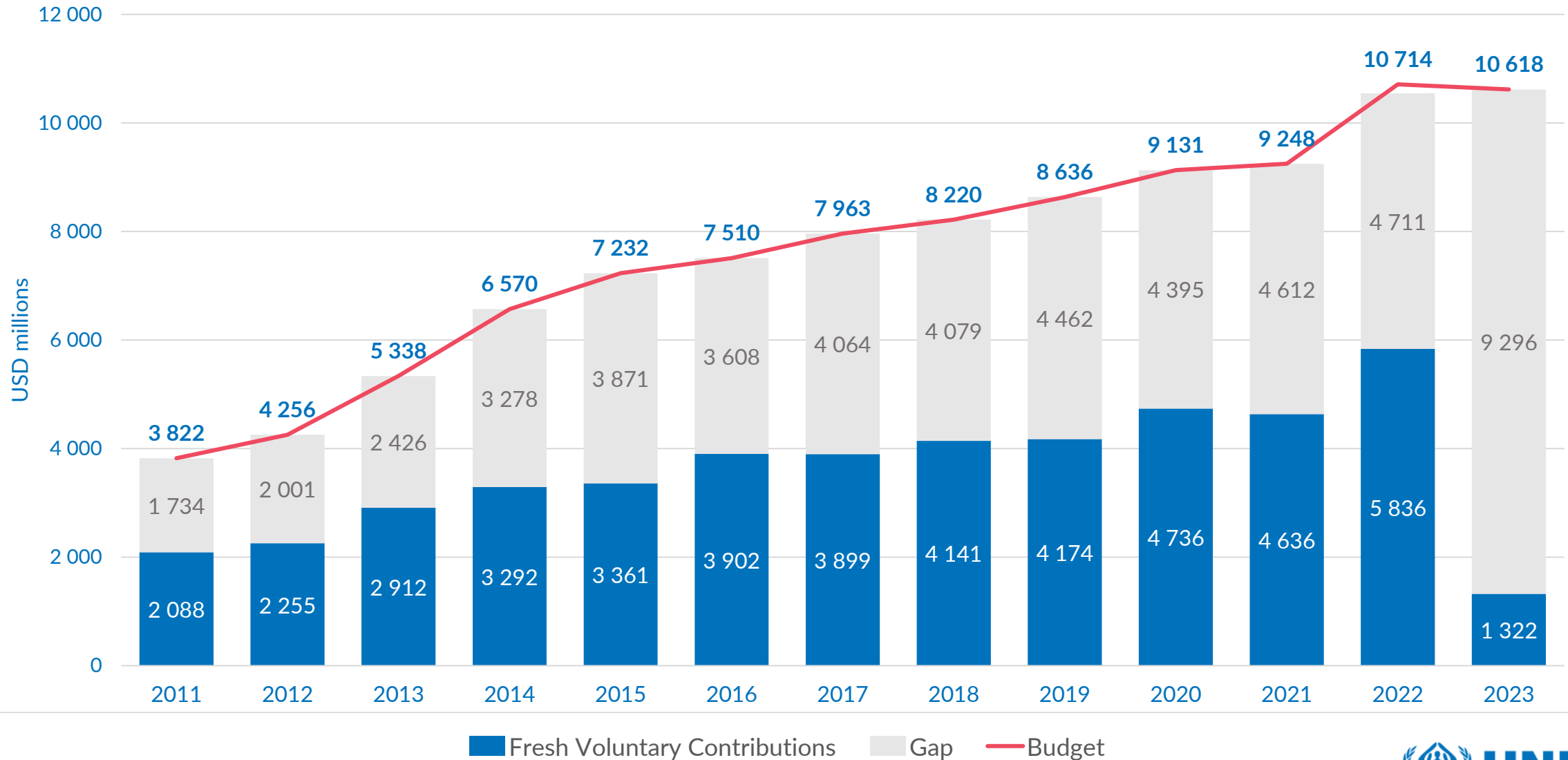

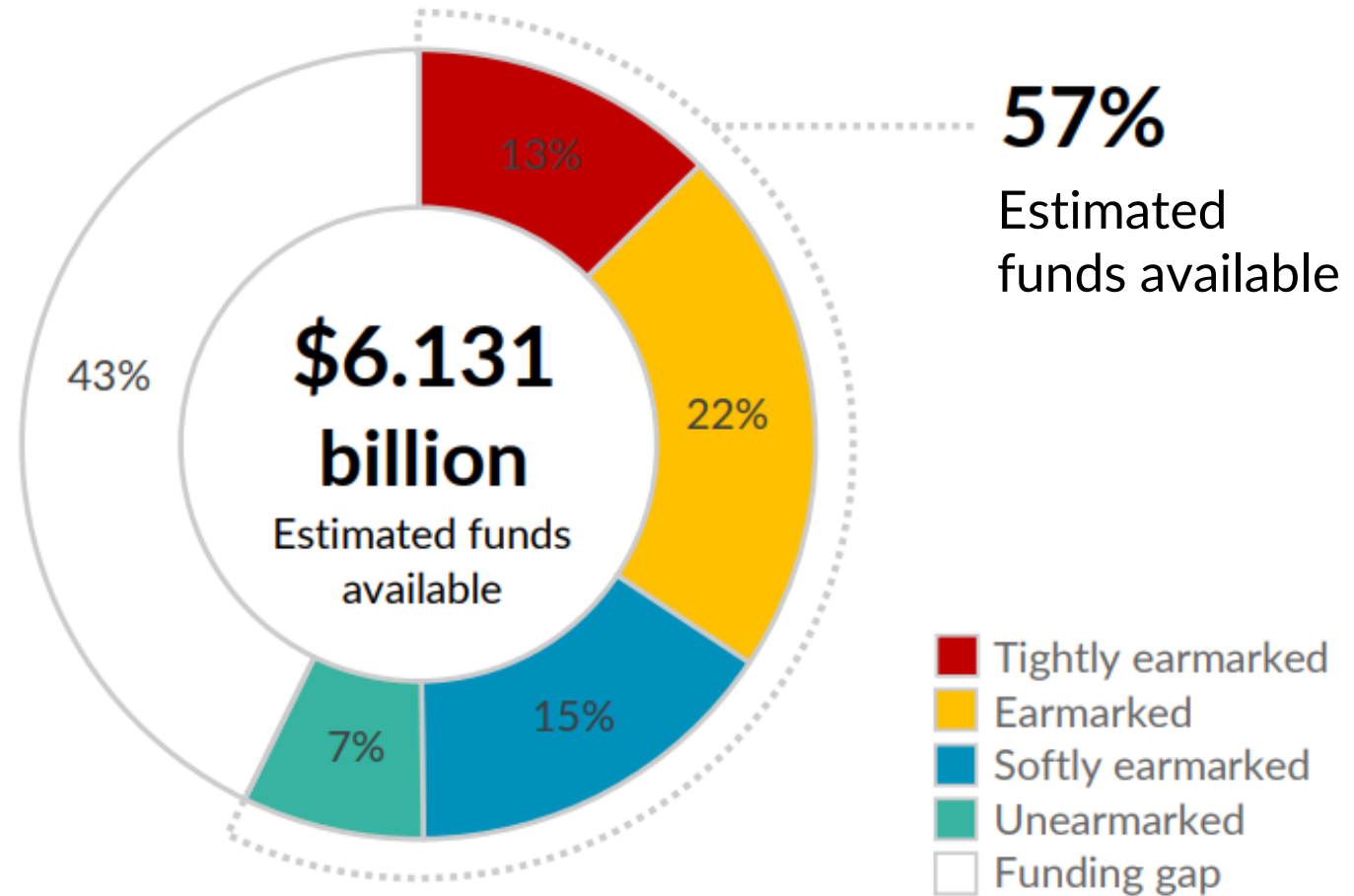
Budget vs. contributions | 2013-2023



Global funding overview in 2022

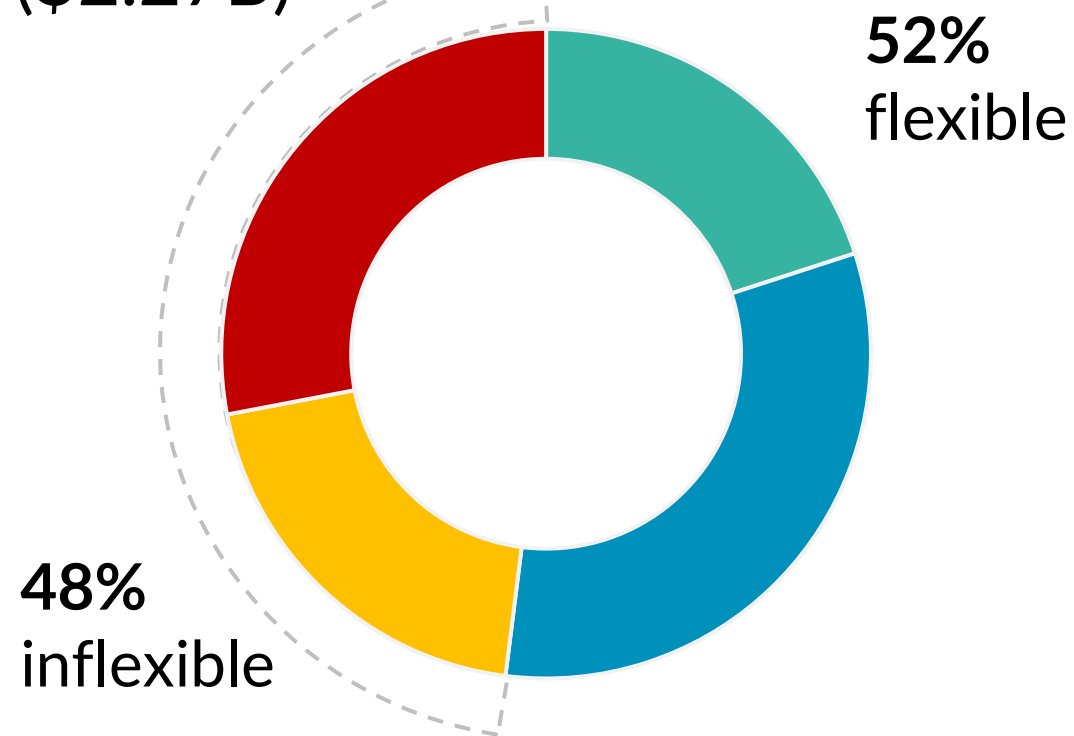

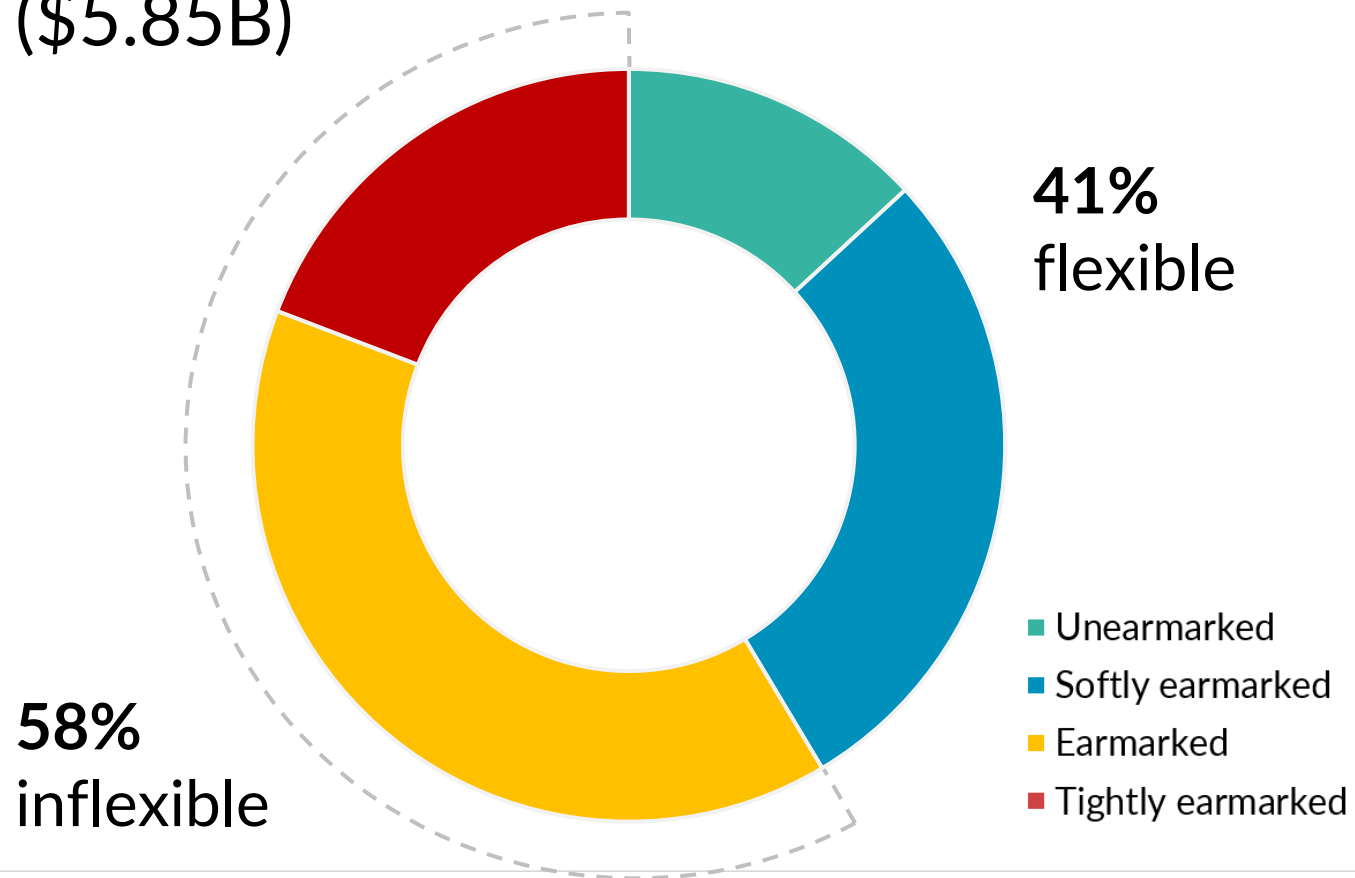

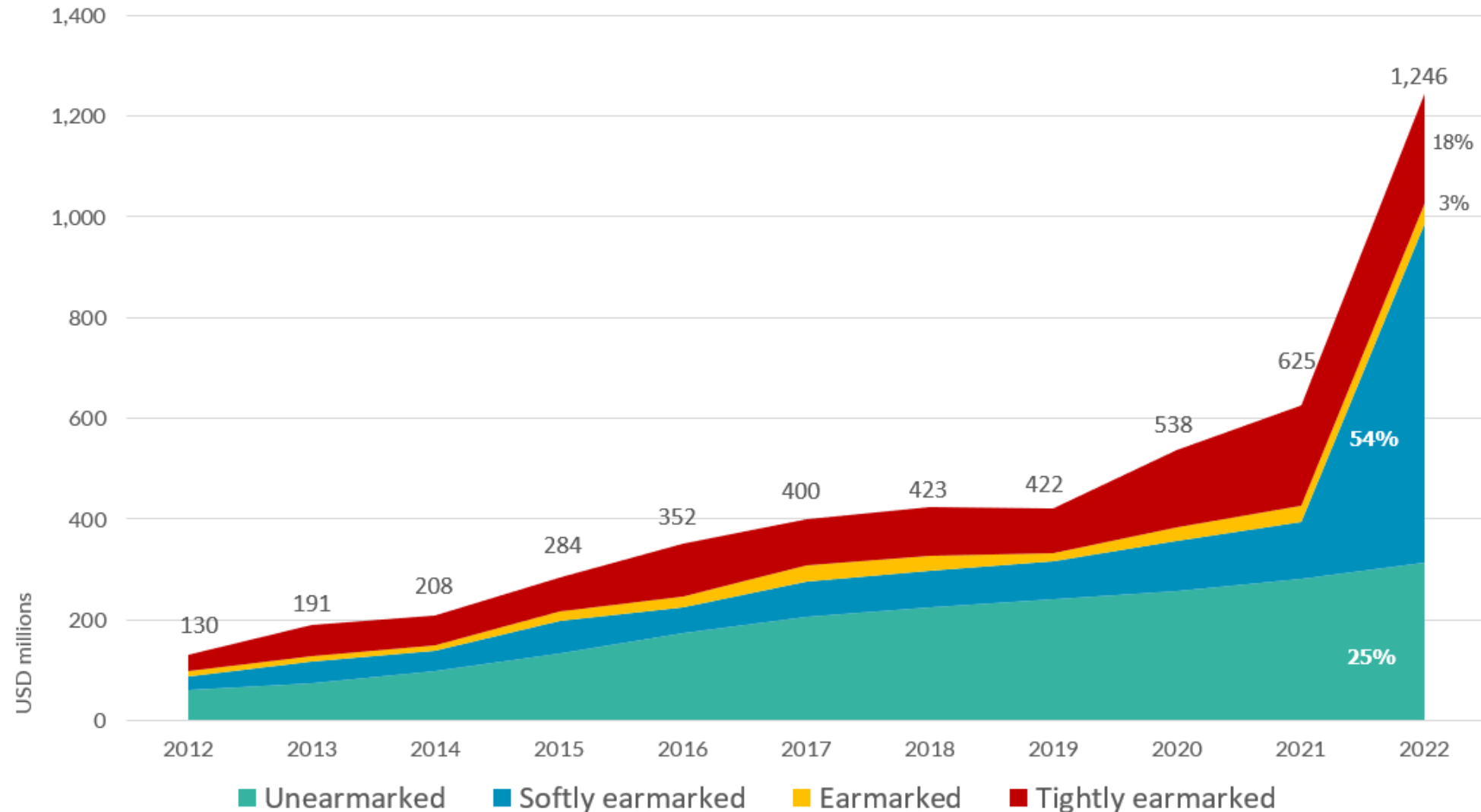

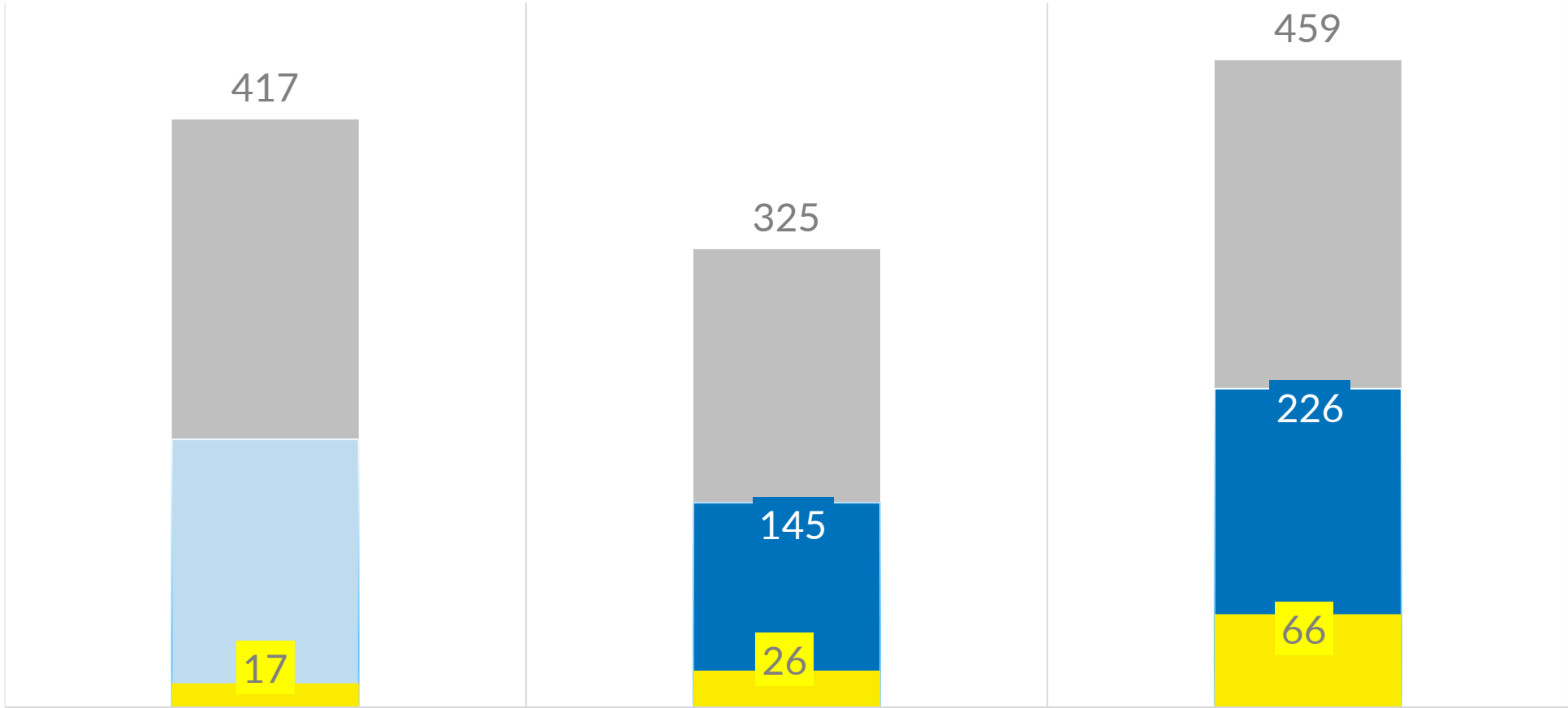
