



**GRANT AGREEMENT
UNDER
THE PROGRAMME OF
THE UNITED NATIONS HIGH COMMISSIONER FOR REFUGEES
(hereafter: this "Agreement")**

PREAMBLE:

- i. The Office of the United Nations High Commissioner for Refugees ("UNHCR") is a subsidiary organ of the United Nations, established by the United Nations General Assembly Resolution 319 (IV) of 3 December 1949, whose objectives are established in the Statute of the Office of the United Nations High Commissioner for Refugees adopted by the United Nations General Assembly in its resolution 428 (V) of 14 December 1950.
- ii. UNHCR recognizes the work and role of the PoC-Partner, identified in the Information Schedule in Section 6 of the Specific Conditions of Contract (the "PoC-Partner"), in responding to challenges and assuming a leadership role within the relevant community, and wishes to contribute financial resources and capacity-development to support the PoC-Partner's work.
- iii. UNHCR and the PoC-Partner (each referred to as "Party" and together as "the Parties") wish to enter into a partnership based on a shared humanitarian commitment to the protection and empowerment of persons of concern to UNHCR.

THE PARTIES HAVE AGREED AS FOLLOWS:

SPECIFIC CONDITIONS OF CONTRACT

Section 1 – Partnership

This Agreement sets out the terms and conditions of the partnership between the Parties. UNHCR will provide financial resources to the PoC-Partner as specified in the Information and Signature Schedule (the "Information Schedule") in Section 6 below. The PoC-Partner accepts these financial resources to carry out activities under its own responsibility in accordance with Annex A and Annex B.

Section 2 – Agreement Documents

This Agreement consists of (i) these Specific Conditions of Contract (the "Specific Conditions"), including the Information Schedule, (ii) the General Conditions of Contract for Grant Agreements (the "General Conditions") identified in the Information Schedule in Section 6 below, (iii) Annex A (Description of Activities) attached hereto, (ii) Annex B (Budget) attached hereto, (iii) Annex C (Code of Conduct) attached hereto, and (iv) any additional annexes specified under the item "Additional Annexes" in the Information Schedule in Section 6 below, which are incorporated herein by reference.

Section 3 – Privileges and Immunities

Nothing in this Agreement shall be deemed a waiver, express or implied, of any of the privileges or immunities enjoyed by the United Nations or by UNHCR.

Section 4 – Settlement of Disputes

The Parties shall use their best efforts to amicably settle any dispute, controversy, or claim arising out of the Agreement or the breach, termination or invalidity thereof. Any dispute, controversy or claim that is not settled amicably within 60 days after receipt by one Party of the other Party's written request for such amicable settlement, shall be submitted to arbitration in accordance with the Arbitration Rules of the United Nations Commission on International Trade Law (UNCITRAL) then obtaining. The decisions of the arbitral tribunal shall be based on general principles of international commercial law. Any award rendered pursuant to such arbitration shall be accepted as a final adjudication by the Parties to which they hereby agree to be bound.

Section 5 – Entry into Force

The Agreement enters into force on the date it is signed by the last of the Parties. If the implementation of activities began at an earlier agreed date as indicated in the Information Schedule in Section 6 below, then this Agreement shall govern the relationship between the Parties as of such earlier date.
